During the 8/24/2022 Budget hearing the following changes were made.

- The district will be Levying \$709 less than the original calculations.
- The \$709 was taken from Volunteer Acknowledgement and Vehicle Maintenance. The Property Tax Replacement amount of \$105 was not shown in the income and was added back to Vehicle Maintenance.
- The Budget was approved as shown below by the WRFPD Board of Fire Commissioners.
