Minutes

Opening Business: MW Brother John R. Heisner, immediate Past Grand Master, Grand Lodge of California welcomed everyone and called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. MW Brother Warren Schoeben, Grand Master, Grand Lodge of Washington, offered the invocation followed by the pledge of allegiance led by MW Brother Heisner.

After introductions, MW Brother Heisner opened the floor for a motion to adopt the conference agenda, which was previously distributed. After it was moved and seconded, the motion was adopted.

MW Brother Heisner asked for a motion to approve the minutes of the February 17, 2017 Conference. RW Brother Ronald Eggers, Senior Grand Warden of the Grand Lodge of Oregon, moved and MW Brother Edward Bousquet, Past Grand Master and Grand Secretary of the Grand Lodge of Oregon, seconded the motion to approve the 2017 minutes. The motion was adopted.

After presentations were completed, the floor was open for emergent topics.

Emergent Topics were then discussed:

MW Brother Heisner introduced a letter requesting admission to the Western Conference from the Grand Lodge of the State of Baja California and provided a brief history of the relationship between this grand lodge and the Grand Lodge of California. Noting that all of the requirements for admission had been met, MW Brother Heisner call for a vote. and the vote was unanimous to admit the Grand Lodge of Baja California as a member of the Western Conference of Grand Lodges. MW Brother Mario Enrique Perez de Alva y Blanco, Grand Master of the Grand Lodge of Baja California, then gave his remarks translated by W Brother Arturo Nikolai Sevilla Covarrubias, Secretary of the Committee on Foreign Relations.
