Who Should Attend

This course is designed for nominated workplace first-aiders, or anyone wanting a comprehensive introduction to first aid.

Course Content

- Communication and delegation in an emergency
- Recognition and Treatment of the following:
 - Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR)
 - Defibrillation
 - Choking Casualty
 - Unconscious Casualty
 - Bleeding
 - Shock
 - Heart Attack
 - Broken Bones, Muscle and Joint Injuries
 - · Burns and Scalds
 - Eye Injuries, including Irrigation
 - Poisons
 - Illnesses i.e. Asthma, Diabetes, Epilepsy
- Personal Hygiene
- Simple Record Keeping
- Contents of First Aid Box
- Purchasing and Ordering Supplies
- Transportation of Casualties

Course Duration

Induction Course – 3 Days Re-qualification – 2 Days

Assessment

Candidates are continually assessed throughout the duration of the course A written assessment will be completed of the final day

Certification

On successful completion of this course and practical assessments, each candidate will receive a certificate allowing them to practise for three years after which a re-qualification course becomes necessary.
