



Q &A: Child Care VS. Part Day School Programs

Does my child receive preschool and k-prep curriculum and instruction while enrolled in childcare?

Yes! We use the same curriculum throughout our childcare programs that we use in our part day school programs! Instruction looks different in every classroom because the students are different in every classroom! Remember in our program we work with the children on an individual level as well as in a group setting! Each classroom will be unique in its instruction and how the day is laid out, but the curriculum and content will be the high standards that Liberty Learning Centers Inc. is known for!

Can my child attend the part day school programs (Scholars, Trail Blazers, Scouts, Pathfinders) while enrolled in childcare?

Yes! However, the part day programs are billed separately from childcare program. This means you would have your childcare tuition and the part day school program tuition as well.

Will I be charged extra for preschool and k-prep curriculum and instruction while enrolled in childcare?

No! When you enroll in Liberty Learning Centers Inc. childcare program the cost of the curriculum and instruction are included in your childcare tuition as a value-added item!

If I want to compare the part day school programs (Scholars, Trail Blazers, Scouts, Pathfinders) hours and days to the curriculum and instruction time my child receives while enrolled in childcare, how many days/hours will my child be in class.

Children enrolled in the part day school programs follow a school calendar. There are days when there is no school scheduled and the part day students do not attend. (Teacher in-service days, holidays, breaks, summer, etc.) Children enrolled in childcare do not have as many of those no school days, so they are automatically receiving more instruction than the part day school students.

Our part day programs only have the option of 2,3, or 4 days with a max of 3.5 hours each day. Children enrolled in childcare receive instruction and curriculum throughout the entire day while the child is in the classroom. We also have breakout sessions for students' multiple times throughout the day! (Remember, each classroom will be unique in its instruction and how the day is laid out, but the curriculum and content will be the high standards that Liberty Learning Centers Inc. is known for!)

What will my child's instruction and curriculum time look while enrolled in childcare?

I know we have said it a couple of times before, however, each classroom will be unique in its instruction and how the day is laid out! We have a schedule, but also understand that there are some days that children need something different than what is listed on the schedule! An example could be: Children arrive in the morning as parents need. The scheduled group instruction time is conducted. When group time is over, the teacher(s) open stations or small group activities for the students. While the students play or do the small group activities, students are called over for their one on one time. This process can take place and be repeated throughout the entire day. During nap time, the students who are older and do not sleep also receive curriculum and instruction time as well!

Do preschool or Kindergarten Prep teachers have to be certified to teach?

No, they do not but we take great pride in the teachers we choose for all of our programs! (Childcare and part day school programs) After we have found the amazing teacher, we train them in our curriculum and instruction methods! Each teacher receives the same guidelines and is held to the same standard of teaching!
