- I. Annual Tuition is \$3,600. Tuition is divided into **10** monthly installments.
- II. \$360 x 10 Months, Starting September through June, for a total of \$3,600 for the school year.
- III. You can take **10%** off if you pay annual tuition in full by Sept. 1st.
- IV. Enrollment Fee is one time fee of **\$250** plus first month's Sept. tuition \$360, a total of **\$610 By Sept. 1st**.
- V. *Cost of School Curriculum Books for the entire year, these are ordered by the school by the first day of school Sept. 9th.
- VI. If tuition is paid beyond the due date of the 5th there will be a \$15 late fee added to your next monthly invoice.
- VII. Tuition can be paid online at www.arisecitychurch.com. There is a \$10 online payment fee which will be added to your next monthly invoice.
- VIII. Tuition can also be paid by Checks made out to "Arise City Church" and by cash and dropped off in the lobby tuition box in the proper filled out envelope.
- IX. Monthly Invoices will be sent by the 25th of each month to your provided email address.
- X. Additional school fees include minimum **uniform** fees of **\$90** per student which includes (2) School Polo Shirts and (2) School Sweater, (2) Gym Shorts. Students everyday must wear proper shoes and blue pants. School uniforms are **required** to be worn every day at school.
- XI. School enforces a strict dress code, which includes proper Physical Education Clothes for P.E. class.
- XII. No hats, slippers or ripped jeans can be worn during normal school period.
- XIII. If your child is not picked by 3:15pm you will be charged an additional \$15 on your next monthly invoice.
- XIV. After school program is available at \$20 each hour up to 2 hours, 3pm-5pm
- XV. Each enrolling family and student must schedule and entrance interview with the Senior Pastor and Principal of the school before September 1st. Interviews will be held during the week of August 24th – 28th.

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

A Christ-Centered Foundation for Early Learning

Arise Academy's Kindergarten Program is designed to give young learners a strong academic and spiritual foundation. Rooted in biblical truth and supported by the ACE School of Tomorrow curriculum, our program nurtures each child's growth in reading, writing, mathematics, character development, and early leadership skills.

CURRICULUM FRAMEWORK

Our Kindergarten program utilizes the **ACE School of Tomorrow Kindergarten with Ace and Christi** curriculum. This proven, mastery-based system introduces students to essential academic concepts while reinforcing Christian values.

Core Learning Areas

- **Phonics & Early Reading** – Students learn letter sounds, blends, word formation, and early reading fluency.
- **Mathematics Foundations** – Counting, number recognition, basic addition/subtraction concepts, shapes, patterns, and problem-solving.

ACADEMICS



- Your student will be academically diagnosed and assessed to ensure your student begins at an academic level they are proficient in. Assessment tests are a full day of test in the core academic subjects.
- The PACE program is a series of books that are given to the student throughout the academic year. The student can excel by completed more than the minimum PACE books required to reach their current grade level if they are academically behind.
- Students are expected to complete a minimum of 60 PACE books per academic school year. To be on track there are required to complete a minimum of 15 PACE books per quarter.
- Students set academic goals everyday. A minimum of 18-25 combined pages in their academic PACE books. What they do not finish they will be issued homework assignments.

THE EDUCATIONAL CONCEPT OF A.C.E. WAS BUILT ON FIVE BASIC LAWS OF LEARNING:

- 1) The Student Must Be Placed On A Level Of Curriculum Where He/She Can Best Perform.
- 2) The Student Must Set Reasonable And Appropriate Goals That Can Be Achieved In A Reasonable And Prescribed Period Of Time.
- 3) The Student Must Receive Motivation Through Encouragement And Support And Achieve Control Through Guidance And Discipline In Order To Assimilate, Use, And Experience The Educational Material.
- 4) The Student’s Learning Must Have Appropriate Measurement Applied To The Results.
- 5) The Student’s Learning Must Receive Recognition And Reward For Its Value, Effort, And Significance.
