To ensure the appropriate atmosphere for Adult Sports, the City of Maricopa has adopted the enforcement of these Codes of Conduct for Participants, Spectators, Officials & Staff.

# **Team Captain Code of Conduct**

- 1. Responsible for communicating all program information, including weekly updates/reminders to their teams and their spectators.
- 2. Responsible for providing valid contact information for Team Captain and a Co-Captain.
- 3. Responsible for communicating with program Staff. i.e. forfeits, protests, roster additions or deletions, program suggestions or feedback, etc.
- 4. Respect Staff & Referee's decisions on and off the court/field.

#### **Players & Spectators Code of Conduct**

- 1. Play for enjoyment, have fun!
- 2. Demonstrate good sportsmanship throughout the season. Be kind please.
- 3. Respect all participants, spectators, Staff & Referees' on and off the field.
- 4. Responsible for their behavior. Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated.
- 5. Refrain from using foul language and any violent behavior.
- 6. Cooperate with other participants, Umps & staff to start the games on time.
- 7. Respect and use all program equipment appropriately.
- 8. Please watch your children and clean up after themselves when exiting the facility.

## Official's Code of Conduct

- 1. Demonstrate good sportsmanship throughout the season.
- 2. Shall exercise authority in an impartial firm and controlled manner.
- 3. Shall uphold the honor and dignity of the profession in all interaction with participants, spectators & Staff.
- 4. Responsible to review league rules adopted by the City of Maricopa Parks & Recreation and enforce during program games.

### **Administrators Code of Conduct**

- 1. Ensure that equal opportunities for participation in all Adult Sports are made available to all participants, regardless of ability, size, shape, gender, age, disability or ethnic origin.
- 2. Equipment and facilities must be of safe and appropriate for participants, Umps, Staff and spectators.
- 3. Remember that the City of Maricopa's Adult Sports are played primarily for recreation.
- 4. Ensure that Team Captains, Staff, Umps and participants all understand their responsibilities regarding safe-play in Adult Recreation Sports.
