Swiss Aid For Ukraine

Request for humanitarian aid

Dear Sirs,

I would like to express my profound respect to you and your charity organization and hope to receive a humanitarian aid to Department of Healthcare at Kyiv Agrarian University (Kyiv, Ukraine).

From the first days of the russian aggression against Ukraine, we have been actively doing medical and humanitarian aid to civil population and military personnel from Armed Forces of Ukraine. After the deoccupation of the parts of Ukraine, we actively provide medical aid to the population of these deoccupied territories, relocated people from the occupied territories as well as residents of the near combat field area. Considering the tasks of university, our Department of Healthcare staff of the Department of Healthcare performs health check ups in deoccupied regions as well as providing rehabilitation measures for the population and military personnel Kyiv. Unfortunately, the current economy situation is bad in Ukraine, and there are only 2 patients out of 10 from the abovementioned area in Ukraine have a possibility to attend medical facilities in medical centers. And because of such problems, we frequently see advanced oncology and non-communicable diseases cases among that cohort of patients. The Department of healthcare also performs investigations of the war consequences on population health in relation to the significant changes of the environment by the pollution of the air, soil and water followed by toxic accumulations in the food are associated with the risk for health in population of Ukraine residing the areas after the russian occupation or after the active combat casualties, causing significant negative ecology changes with the negative impact on population health. Although, the research capacities of university encompass specific equipment to detect specific parameters from air, soil, water, but investigation of the population health requires additional tools, such as mobile ultrasonography machine. Considering such challenges, we would be grateful for portable ultrasound machine equipped with linear (7-13 MHz) and convex probes to continue providing our humanitarian mission as well as to provide high-specialized medical care for the most suffered population cohorts in Ukraine.
