The Nutter Center for Empowering Women's SUCCESS Program is a 5-Step Program that was created to empower, educate and attain sustainable wage employment, to help break the generational cycle of welfare dependency and out-of-wedlock pregnancies.

The Gap Initiative is a local non profit providing tutoring, mentorship and behavioral health services to low-performing students who have challenges thriving in a traditional classroom setting.
