Patient Instructions For Pulmonary Function Testing

- 1. Please Report To The Office 15 minutes Prior to Scheduled Appointment.
- 2. Do Not Smoke 2 Hours Prior to Test.
- 3. Do Not Wear Tight Fitting Clothing Which Restricts Chest Expansion.
- 4. Do Not Take Respiratory Drugs Prior to Testing As Indicated Below:
 - Inhaled Short Acting Bronchodilators 4 Hours Prior to Testing:
 Proventil, ProAir, Ventolin HFA, Xopenex HFA, Xopenex Solution (levalbuterol),
 Atrovent HFA, Duo-neb (Albuterol-Ipratropium Bromide), Albuterol Solution,
 Combivent Respirat, Performist, Brovana
 - Inhaled Long Acting Bronchodilators & Inhaled Corticosteroids 12 Hours Prior to Testing: Advair, Symbicort, Azmacort, Foradil, Qvar, Dulera, Spiriva, Pulmicort, Flovent, Alvesco, Asmanex, Tudorza, Arcapta, Breo
- 5. Take All Other Medications as Directed.
