






Camp Just One

Camp Just One is a week-long program for kids grades 6-12. Each week focuses on a different theme where students learn from professionals in their field through hands-on experiences and field trips.

Created by our team and a Licensed Clinical Psychologist, this program introduces values around civic engagement, volunteerism, crucial life skills, youth empowerment, teamwork, and leadership development.
