Dear Door County Resident,

The Door County Invasive Species Team (DCIST) has been a model cooperative weed management group for the state, bringing together natural resource groups present in your community, for over 20 years!

In 2024, with the help of various Invasive Species Education and Outreach grants, Cooperative Weed Management grants, Invasive Species Control grants and donations obtained through generous donors such as yourself, the DCIST was afforded the opportunity to:

- Offer training and outreach for invasive species identification and monitoring, participating in over <u>16 webinar, interviews, and</u> volunteer events. Engaging over 25,000 people though news interviews, media platforms, and one-on-one site visits.
- Promote the adoption of Door County priority/Phragmites ordinances in ten towns and the city of Sturgeon Bay. DCIST
 continues to conduct outreach and education within these municipalities to ensure successful ordinance implementation.
- Install <u>2 CD3 boat cleaning stations and 2 simplified boat cleaning stations</u>, providing aquatic invasive species prevention tools to over 95% of county boat launch users. <u>Install 3 boot brush stations</u> along the Ahnapee Trail.
- Inventory and control <u>225 acres</u> of priority invasive species.
