### **Drain**

Remove plugs and drain livewells & ballast.

Use the provided vacuum to remove any water leftover or on deck.



# Dry

Use the provided air compressor to dry all wet parts of watercraft and trailer.



# **Dispose**

Make sure all unused bait or leftover organic material is properly disposed of in trash or compost.
