It was quiet at Seeley Lake Checkpoint late this afternoon. Teams are either on their way to Owl Creek Wilderness Checkpoint or are there resting.

The first one on her way today to Owl Creek was Jessie Royer at 9:20. She is on her way back to Seeley Lake Checkpoint where there is a mandatory 6 hour layover before heading to White Tail Ranch and to the finish at Hi-Country Snack Foods. At printing, she is about 25 miles out of Owl Creek on her way to Seeley Lake.

Bailey Vitello is also starting on his way back to Seeley Lake Checkpoint. The rest are schedule to start back now that the temperatures are cooler. Owl Creek is about 151 miles into the 300 Mile Race and the turn-around point.

At Owl Creek is Josi Thyr, Bryce Mumford, Clayton Perry, Cindy Gallea and Jed Stephenson.

Bino Fowler and Jesse Flory are heading to Owl Creek starting before dark.

Rex Mumford of Huntsville, Utah, withdrew late this afternoon along with Wade Donaldson of Coalville, Utah and Morgan Anderson of Enterprise, Oregon last night.

There is a time gap between Seeley Lake and Owl Creek. Communications are limited. Temperatures are supposed to be colder tonight with some light snow tomorrow. The temperatures have been warm this year.
