Total Giving in December was very generous, as you can see the Giving to Expenses comparison was in the black! Even though we ended December in the black, our year to date is still greatly in the red.

The shared expenses percentage for 2026 has been calculated and Augustana will be responsible for 67% with East Sveadahl supporting 33% of these expenses. This is a change from 64% for Augustana and 36 % for East Sveadahl in 2024.
