No AES Ministries members were present to present concerns.

Prayer concerns and praises were shared, and Pr. Mandy led us in prayer.

The secretary's report was accepted as presented in the August Newsletter.

#### PR. MANDY'S REPORT

She is very positive about her return to a very busy ministry. #### EAST SVEADAHL COUNCIL MINUTES -- August 8, 2024

The East Sveadahl Church Council met on Thursday, August 8, 2024 at 7 pm at East Sveadahl. Those present were Tom Anderson, Wayne Jurgens, Janet Bloomquist, Dana Avila, Lori Urevig, Cindy Torkelson, Kris Suess, Pastor Mandy, Sonja Coleman, and Susan Anderson.

Tom Anderson, Council Chairman, called the meeting to order and Pastor Mandy opened with prayer. Secretary, Janet, presented the July 9, 2024 minutes and they were approved as read.

Sonja Coleman, Financial Secretary, presented her report, and Kris Suess presented the treasurer's report. A motion by Wayne, seconded by Janet, and passed to approve the reports as presented.

## Pastor Mandy presented the following:

- There will be a funeral on Tuesday, August 13 at East.
- We had campers at Lake Shetek & Green Lake Bible Camps and Pastor Mandy visited Green Lake.
- Pastor Mandy attended a continuing ed class entitled "Women In Ministry" in Sioux Falls. The class was covered by grant money obtained by the Synod and was very good.
- Study group on Monday, August 12 is cancelled due to the funeral on Tuesday.
- Since Confirmation was changed to a two-year program for 9-10 graders, Pastor Mandy is having a preconfirmation class entitled "Youtherans" for 6-8 graders once a month which will be held at both East and Augustana alternately on Sundays. There will be lessons and youth group activities

- Brewed Theology in July had 32 people in attendance. August 28 at 7 p.m. will be another session at the Eagles at 7 p.m.
- August 21-28 Pastor Mandy will be on vacation. Deacon Lyla will be on call and will be pulpit supply.
- Sunday, September 8 is "God's Work. Our Hands" Sunday. Each church will have their own service.
- Sunday, September 15 is a joint service at Augustana with Bully Pulpit at 10 a.m. and lunch to follow. All proceeds will go the AES camper fund.
- Sunday, September 29 is the fifth Sunday with a joint service at East beginning at 10 a.m. It is also Rally Sunday and a pulpit exchange Sunday with AES, First Presbyterian, and First Lutheran. AES will have Pastor Andy from First Lutheran as guest pastor that Sunday.
- Sunday, October 6 the service times change.
- Sunday, October 13 is tentatively set for Harvest Blessing Sunday at East.

#### AUGUSTANA LUTHERAN CHURCH COUNCIL MINUTES - August 14, 2024

**Present** - Lyle Anderson, Sandy Berg, Doug Erdal, Kirsten Freitag, Jim Harrington, Stan Kunkel, Darrick Miest, Pastor Mandy, Jeff Price, Dean Swenstad, Lynn Watson

Absent - Jill Beckius

Meeting was called to order at 7:08. Pastor Mandy started the meeting with Prayer.

Motion by Lynn to approve the minutes from the last meeting and seconded by Kirsten

Reports: Lauren presented the Treasurer's report. Noted she is continuing to work with Judy T on how to do reports. She also noted that she had looked into a new Cloud (backup system) for her work she does on Church Windows. Currently we use Church Windows cloud at the church which costs \$1,900 a year, and Judy had used Backblaze at home to back-up her work which is only \$72 a year. After discussion the committee had a motion by Jeff and seconded by Darrick to switch our church account to Backblaze. Lauren also noted that the utilities have been paid by the church, and that the men's group had said they were going to pay for this. Darrick asked her to give him the bills, and they will give the money to them for the bills. Lynn asked on behalf of the Education Committee (ROAR) if they could have their own checkbook. Lauren was not sure due to the fact she had been informed that the previous treasurer was not in favor of them having their own account. After some discussion and looking back in our minutes it has been approved several months ago. Motion was made by Lynn and seconded by Sandy that ROAR is able to get their own account with having 2 people on the account, one from Augustana and one from East. Deanna shared the giving report, and we are up around \$10,000 from last year, much of this increase is from people giving from their retirement funds. (continued)

Deanna had checked into other options for types of envelopes, etc., and it was much higher because of the shipping.

AES Ministries - They spent much of their time discussing the annual picnic. They also went through worship times for services. Services times are as follows: Sept 8th 9:00 worship service God's Work Our Hands; Sept 15th Joint worship service at 10:00 am at Augustana with Bully Pulpit and a Free Will offering Meal for Camperships served by the youth families who attended camp; Sept 22nd 9:00 am worship service / New Members Sunday; Sept 29th Joint Service at 10:00 am at East / Rally Sunday for ROAR. Note (Pastor Mandy will not be leading service, Pastor Andy will be from First Lutheran, and she will be leading worship at the Presbyterian church, Pastor Swap Sunday). Note time change is happening in October for services Oct 6<sup>th</sup> 9;00 am service, Oct 13th 9:00 am Harvest Blessing. They also discussed the Coordinator of Youth position. Pastor Mandy's Report - Pastor Mandy reported the VBS was a huge success, and they averaged around 100 children per day. She also noted that Augustana will be the host place for the 2025 VBS. She noted that the youth/chaperones who attended the New Orleans (NOLA) trip shared their experiences on Aug 11th at the joint service at East. She stated it was an amazing / wonderful trip. She also noted that the 2027 National Youth Gathering will be held in Minneapolis, MN. Pastor Mandy stated that we had youth this year at two different camps with the younger ones at Lake Shetek, and the older ones at Green Lake. She was able to go up and visit the older kids at Green Lake on Monday. Pastor Mandy shared the feedback about Lake Shetek Camp as it was our first year having children attend, and the feedback was they enjoyed the camp much more than Green Lake and had many activities for them to do. Between the two camps around 12 youth attended, and some of the youth went as Community Guides. The church will be looking at the two options for next year with the positive feedback they got back about Lake Shetek, and also looking and taking in consideration that the Shetek camp is 1/3 of the cost of Green Lake, it is an hour closer, and has a lot more ministries. Pastor Mandy reported she held Brewed Theology at the Eagles, and it was well attended with around 35 or so people. The next one will be Aug 28th. She has been holding a Bible Study group out at East on Mondays from 3pm to 4pm but is going to rename it as a Study Group, as they have a variety of topics. She noted her numbers went up by a couple and is averaging around 9 people now. Pastor Mandy attended a conference Aug 6-8th in Sioux Falls, the topic of the conference was Woman in Ministry. Pastor Mandy is counseling a couple for their Pre-Marital Counseling with the wedding being in Oct. Pastor Mandy will be on vacation from Aug 21-28. Deacon Lyla will be on call and will do Pulpit Supply on the 25th. Pastor Mandy will have Baptisms on Sept 1st and 8th. A new youth group is being formed for grades 6-8th and the group will be called Youtherans. They will meet 1 time a month on Sunday evening with 30 min. lessons, and then do more youth group activities. Pastor Mandy will send out letters this week. Jr. High Gathering in Willmar will be in Nov. Our expenses for Vacation Bible School were \$296.34 and will be split between East.

**Education** - They are working on setting up registration for Wednesday night ROAR from 6pm to 7pm with having a meal 1 time a month before ROAR. They are also working at getting supplies and lessons ready for this Fall.

**Worship, Music & Technology** - They met on Aug 5<sup>th</sup> (youth) Kaitlyn and Jenna brought ideas about changing worship up by having a more contemporary service. The worship committee was very open to the ideas and are planning to have more traditional services on the 1st and 2nd Sunday of the month and on the 3rd and 4th more of a contemporary service. Starting Sept 1st we will use the <u>Come, Let us Worship</u>. Pastor Mandy reported that Terry E. had found a Public Domain of Pre-Recorded hymns and they sounded very good. We will be using Pre-Recorded Music on Aug 25th. We will use this resource when we don't have an Organist as Heidi will remain a part time organist.

**Evangelism/Social Ministry** - The group will be working on Gift Bags to Welcome New Members. God's Work. Our Hands / Coffee Hour

**Finance** - They talked about the cloud that was part of Lauren's report, and Darrick and Deanna discussed with the group the cost of offering envelopes and will need to continue to look into.

**Property/ Cemetery** - Dean and Stan mowed cemetery. Ryan Reed sold his business, but the person who bought it will continue to mow it at no cost as Ryan had until the end of the season. The new owner will then give us a quote to mow the lawn and cemetery. We will have to re-budget for this or look for volunteers. The

mowing takes around 8 to 9 hours. We had a leak in the dishwashing room. Plumbers came and looked, and it was leaking from under the flooring. The plumbers will be rerouting how our water supply works.

Youth - Youth who attended the National Youth Gathering in New Orleans spoke about their experience on Aug 11th. Youth will be working at the Threshing Bee in Butterfield at the Steamer Cafe as a fundraiser from 6 to 10:30 am on Aug 18th. On Sept 7th, youth will be setting up and serving at LaSalle's 125th Anniversary. Youth Committee will discuss the menu for the Oct 6th Stewardship meal. Oct 23rd will be serving for the Confirmation banquet. We are planning a Bonfire and Night games for grades 6-12 in Oct but need to talk to Tom Anderson to see if we can do this. We also discussed the Calendar through May with ideas and fundraisers. As a youth committee we want to get out a calendar with events, activities, and dates to each youth so they can see upcoming events and make plans to save the dates. We also discussed talking to youth to come to our meetings either monthly or quarterly has not been decided yet, but we would like to hear what they would like to do for activities, and service projects.

Old Business - We discussed the need to fill a council position. A couple of options on how to fill the position can be: 1. We discussed updating our member's directory. Sandy Berg said she would talk to Arica Connell to see if she would be willing to help out with making a new directory. Sandy stated she talked to Arica, and she said she would be willing to help out. Council would like more information/details on the process and are hoping Arica could come to the next Council Meeting in Sep. Sandy will check to see if she is available. We also talked about who could do the photography part of the directory, and Dean was going to talk to Heather. We also have other members whom we can ask. A question was asked if we could also have East members in our directory with their information, as we are a two-point parish and many times we send cards to members, and it would be nice to have their address. We will discuss this with East. It was brought to the council's attention that John and Cec took care of maintaining the organ.

**New Business** - New Members Sunday will be Sept 22<sup>nd</sup>. New Member class will be held Sept 10th. Sept 15th Bully Pulpit with Meal / Donations will go to Camperships.
