Thank you for your patience,

Due to the presence of Covid-19, we are taking the following precautions here at Flash Electric to keep you and our community safe:

- ◆ Checking our technicians' temperatures before they go out to their first call each day. If any tech has a temperature over 99 degrees, send them home and require they see a physician.
- ◆ Ask technicians to take their own temperature each evening. If they (or another household member) have a temperature over 99 degrees, require them to stay home and see a physician.
- ◆ Have technicians wear personal protective equipment such as face masks, disposable gloves, disposable shoe covers and eye protection/safety glasses – when safe to do so according to LNI and OSHA.
- ◆ Equip each service vehicle with soap and water for hand washing between service calls and encourage frequent use.
- ◆ Provide technicians with alcohol based hand-sanitizer if soap and running water are not available — before and after using the bathroom, before and after eating, after coughing/sneezing/blowing nose.
- ◆ Require technicians to maintain 6 feet of distance between themselves and clients; or gatherings of two or more people at all times, alongside identifying “choke points” and “high risk areas” to help keep 6 feet of distance — 6 feet of distance may include minimizing interactions when picking up and receiving job site materials as well.
- ◆ Require technicians wipe down surfaces near their work area(s) at each job — before, during and after.
- ◆ No sharing of pens, and a paper copy of invoice will only be left at clients request.
- ◆ Online payment is encouraged.

We would also like to recommend that when our technicians are working in a specific area of the home, that our clients consider planning on being in a different area during that time.

As an added safety measure, we are currently offering virtual pricing appointments..

At this time there is no projected date for our services to return to normal operations.
