Hymn of the Month: LSB 930 All You Works of God Bless the Lord (in your hymnal)

Catechism Corner Learn By Heart Lord's Prayer, Conclusion; Divine Service 3 Offertory, LSB 19

Read up for this Sunday, Pentecost 17 — Isaiah 50:4–10; James 3:1–12; Mark 9:14–29

Discuss at home: How is it possible for a weary person to be sustained with a spoken word? What predictions of Jesus' suffering did Isaiah give in this portion of his prophecy? Why does God hold teaching to be so important? How can great evil and great blessing potentially come from the same tongue? If no one can "tame the tongue", what can be done to limit the damage it can do? How could Jesus' disciples do the same miracles He was doing during His ministry? When the disciples could not do the miracle requested, what does Jesus cite as the problem? What does the father's plea ("Lord, I believe; please help my unbelief!") do to encourage us to pray, even when we don't know what to pray for?

Prayer: Lord Jesus Christ, our support and defense in every need, continue to preserve Your Church in safety, govern her by Your goodness, and bless her with Your peace; for You live and reign with the Father and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever. Amen.
