Who May Receive the Lord's Supper

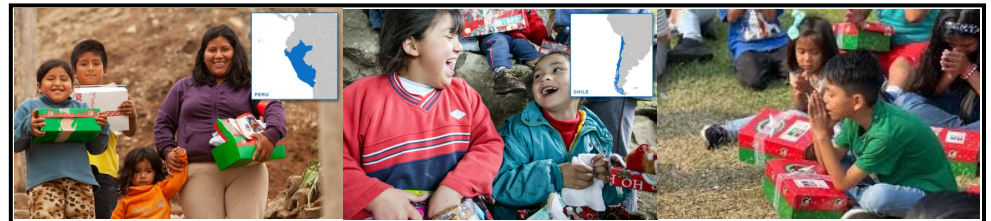
Jesus invites everyone that has professed faith in Him to participate in the Lord's Supper even if you are a member in good standing at another church.
