Sermon Notes

Do you pray for others? *How do you pray for them?* Is it only for their physical and financial needs? The prayers of Jesus, Paul, and the other New Testament writers focus primarily on hearts, souls, spiritual power, and unseen spiritual realities.

Big question: What is it about God that motivates us to pray for others?

1. Our God is a God of PURPOSE. (vs. 14.)

"From the Bible, we quickly learn that God is more interested in our holiness than our comfort. He more greatly delights in the integrity and purity of His church than in the material well-being of its members. He shows Himself more clearly to men and women who delight IN HIM and OBEY HIM than to men and women whose horizons revolve around good jobs, nice houses, and reasonable health. He is far more committed to building a corporate "temple" in which His Spirit dwells than He is preserving our reputations. He is more vitally disposed to display His grace than to flatter our intelligence. He is more concerned for justice than for our ease. He is more deeply committed to stretching our faith than our popularity. He prefers that His people live in disciplined gratitude and holy joy rather than pushy self-reliance and glitzy happiness. He wants us to pursue daily death, not self-fulfillment, for the latter leads to death, while the former leads to life. These essential values of the Gospel must shape our praying, as they shape Paul's. Indeed, they become the ground for our praying. It is a wonderful comfort, a marvelous boost to faith, to know that you are praying in line with the declared will of almighty God." (Spiritual Reformation, Carson pg. 200.)

 Our God is a FATHER to those who trust Him. (vs. 14.) Matthew 7: 9 "Which of you, if your son asks for bread, will give him a stone? 10 Or if he asks for a fish, will give him a snake? 11 If you, then, though you are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in heaven give good gifts to those who ask him!

3. Our God is not LIMITED by ANYTHING! (vs. 21.)

Remember Old Mother Hubbard? She lived in a shoe. She had so many children she didn't know what to do! Our God knows what to do with His children!

4. Our God is a GLORIOUS God. (vs. 21.)

Challenge: Pray for hearts, souls, strength, and spiritual power! Ask the Lord to transform us, use us to reach others, and bring about renewal in our city!
