## Introduction

May 2026, while writing *Line 5: The Hands That Rocked Time* (L5:THTRT), I solved the mysteries of the Messiah Emanuel, and the mysteries of the prophet Elijah, and the Virgin Mary. To create this mini-book, I've re-published large portions of two sections of L5:THTRT: about 70% of Chapter 1, Part I, and 95% of Chapter 1, Part II.

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There are 5,355 words in this book.

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You can read the *Notes* mentioned in the following passages

# CHAPTER 1

## Part I

### Somewhere In Time

Since the beginning of human life on Earth, mankind has traversed seven timelines, which include four major timeline changes; two of which were reversals, each of which caused two timeline changes. Chapter 1 of this book, divided into four parts, explains the 7 timelines, paying extra attention to the first 4 lines. The remainder of the book focuses on lines 5, 6 and 7. The Line 5 story really begins in Chapter 3.

For the purposes of this book, a timeline is a period of continuous human life, uninterrupted by unnatural events. A *timeline change* or *shift* happens when life and events on a timeline are changed for reasons that are not caused by God, Jesus or *Natas* (God's Daughter, effectively Mother Nature).

All of this may sound far-fetched, but I believe most of you will accept much of this long before you finish this book. As the story progresses, you'll see historical evidence, artistic/artifact evidence, Biblical evidence, logical evidence and scientific evidence of these timeline changes.

For clarity, my timeline count of 7 omits all of God and Jesus' interventions on Earth. Each time They intervene, They are deliberately altering the course of humanity's future, for the better. God and Jesus created the universe; thus, They are larger than nature, and Their interventions are in concert with nature. This distinction matters because the four major timeline shifts were all indirectly caused by an unnatural entity: Satan, who evolved out of nature, and whom God sent to Earth. Some of the timeline shifts also involve altering God's Prophecies –or appearing to do so.

#### Satan

Satan, originally named *Lucifer*, began as a human-like being on a different planet. Lucifer died and was admitted into Heaven, where he eventually made it to the highest rank of Angels. Lucifer eventually rebelled, declared War on God, took the name Satan, and was banished to Earth. Because God specifically speaks of Satan, from the earliest Bible book, *Job*, to the most recent, *Revelation*, we understand Satan is the king of demons. As Satan does not originate on Earth, and is defiantly against God and nature, with respect to Earth, Satan is an unnatural entity.

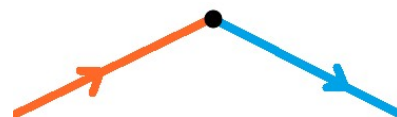
## The Wagers

My books, *The Wagers*, *My Stepdad Was One of the Zodiac's Santa Rosa Hitchhiker Murderers* (MSWOotZSRHM), and *Steve's Top-Secret Notebook* (STSN) give substantial time to God and Satan's Wagers. God did not tell Satan why He banished him to Earth, but let Satan draw his own conclusions. Satan could be useful in providing humans additional testing, to prove themselves worthy or unworthy of Heaven. At War with God, Satan would not ordinarily comply with such a plan; but Satan wanted to acquire new powers from God, to corrupt humans and infuriate God. Hence, inevitably, God and Satan began making Wagers. As Satan won Wagers, or completed lateral tasks required by God to earn new powers,<sup>1</sup> he was usually allowed to keep His new powers.

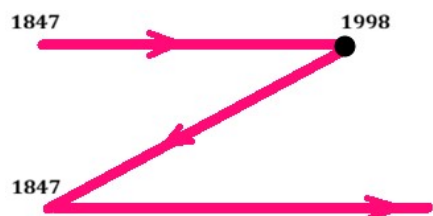
### Timeline Changes

God and Jesus can initiate actions that alter future events, without causing an official timeline change. But if God or Jesus take reactive action to harmful action an unnatural entity like Satan causes, Their action can result in new timeline. There are three types of timeline changes currently known to me. Type #1, theoretically, can be caused by an entity like Satan; types #2 and #3 can only be caused by God or Jesus.

The first type of timeline change I call a **timeline directional shift**. I visualize these changes with sort of a joint shape, pictured to the right. In a directional shift, a huge unexpected event is introduced (represented by the black dot) and humanity's future is drastically altered.



**Z time reversals** are an uncommon and fairly terrifying timeline change. The evidence indicates God and Jesus only utilizes these changes in the most unusual circumstances. To my knowledge, God always depicts time



reversals, as you see to the left, in sort of a **Z** shape. In the *Notes* section, I explain why God presents them this way (if you've got your detective cap on, you should be able to solve this mystery yourself). When God reverses time or restarts it, all of the original timeline history is lost.

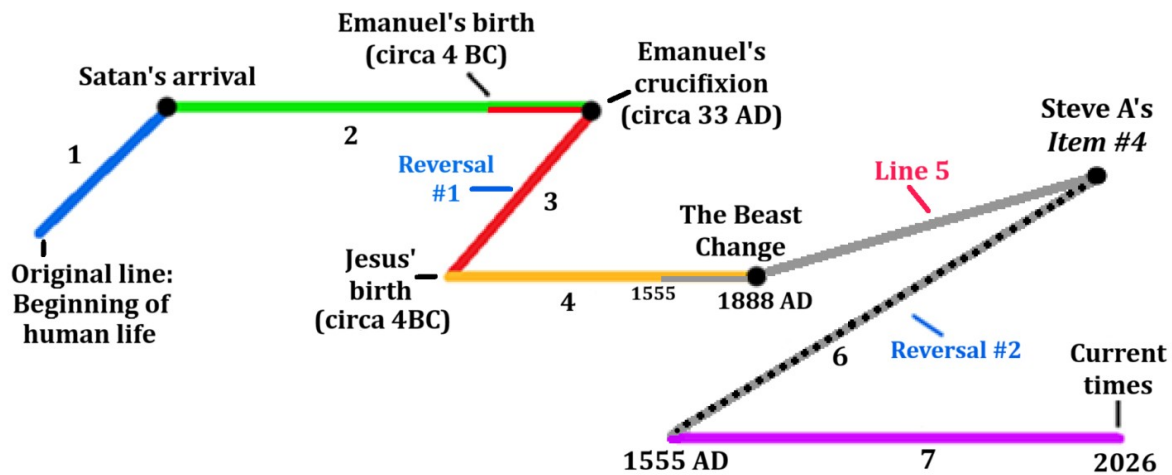


The third shift I call **phantom timeline changes**, for lack of a better name. This is when God cancels or changes a Prophesied event (the *P* in the red circle, to the left) before the event occurs. I believe God would only do this in extremely unusual situations.<sup>2</sup>

<sup>1</sup> Killing Guadalupe notes some of the documentary requirements God places on Satan, lateral to their Wagers; which helped me discover some of these facts.

<sup>2</sup> It's probable that God and Jesus change the future often (e.g., directing large asteroids away from Earth, etc). But we can only *know* a future Event, if God tells us. And we can only know if such a Prophesied Event has changed if we are aware of the Prophecies, and track, study and decode the Prophecies and their corresponding Events.

## The Shape of Time



The graphic above shows the bends and changes of time. The 7 human timelines are: (1) the original line; (2) Satan arrival on Earth; (3) Line 3 is Emanuel's reversal; (4) Emanuel's reversal started Line 4; (5) Line 5 was created by a *phantom* change, at the end of Line 4; (6) Line 6 was a 470 year reversal; (7) the Line 6 reversal led to (created) Line 7, our timeline. All of this will be fully explained in the pages ahead.

## CHAPTER 1, Part II:

# The Life and Crucifixion Of Emanuel

NOTE: This section solves what may be the Bible's greatest mystery, and reveals that Emanuel, God's Son (the first incarnation of Jesus) came to Earth, died for our sins, and fulfilled God's prophecy.

The seven timelines are fairly easy to understand; but lines 2, 3 and 4 require a bit more focus to follow, because the death of Emanuel impacts three timelines.

### LINE 1

The first timeline ran from the moment humans appeared on Earth (Genesis, chapters 1 and 2 covers this period), until the moment Satan appeared on Earth.

### LINE 2

Timeline 2 begins when Satan arrives on Earth.

Because God cannot be physically harmed, Satan's goal was to use humanity, whom God cares for, to hurt God. Timeline 2 ends just after the death of Emanuel, the Savior. Emanuel's death creates Line 3 –a reversal timeline. But since a death is meaningless without the life, Emanuel's life on Line 2 is also part of Line 3.

Satan would love to claim credit for creating Line 2, but Satan did not send himself to Earth. God sent Satan; thus, God caused Line 2.

### LINE 3: The MYSTERY of Emanuel

The Line 3 solution shows Emanuel came, completed his work, and fulfilled God's Prophecies. Uniquely, Line 3 is created *after* Emanuel's death, but should be viewed as beginning at Emanuel's birth on Line 2, and following Emanuel's reversal back in time, and ending at Jesus birth –Emanuel's re-birth, at the beginning of line 4 (see graphic on page 3). Thus, Emanuel ends Line 2, is Line 3, and begins Line 4. His decision to be re-born and re-crucified act as two timeline changes.

One of the keys to solving this mystery are Revelation's verses 11:12, 11:13, and 11:19, all of which refer to 1906, and to John D Rockefeller III, who was born in 1906. Rockefeller was originally Prophesied by God to be the notorious third Beast of Revelation 13:18 fame. But, at the end of Line 4, in 1888, to punish Satan for stealing *Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe's* crown, God replaced Rockefeller with John W Gardner . This change immediately created Line 5. Gardner was a much more murderous beast, whose killing of open-minded White women disastrously impacted White Westerners. However, Revelation verses 11:12, 13 and 19 did not change –God did not reverse time to alter the Bible to identify the new beast in verses 11:12, 13 and 19. This assures us that no actual or prophesied timeline will be erased or forgotten.

The second key to solving the Emanuel mystery is simply observing that the Messiah on Line 2 is named Emanuel, but the Messiah on Timeline 4 is named Jesus. This seems obvious; but, on a higher level, it is God's way of showing us that each person, or Divine entity, on each timeline, has a unique name or identifier.

The third key fact is found in the twenty-third verse of the New Testament, Matthew 1:23, where, just before Jesus' birth, Matthew reminds us of Isaiah's prophecy of the coming of Emanuel (also *Emmanuel* and *Immanuel*), who will be born to a virgin. This is God's determination that the life of Emanuel not be forgotten.

The fourth key clue concerning Emanuel's life and crucifixion is found in the Book of John. The clue is the fact that John never says his name in the Book of John; rather, he refers to himself as "the Disciple whom Jesus loved." John does this four times, to mark the fact he is on Line 4.

What follows is roughly what happened with Emanuel's human life, death and time reversal...

Before God asked Satan to test Jesus, He asked Satan to test Emanuel.

But Satan is at War with God, and demands a high Wager price for all Wagers. So the price of tempting the Son of God would be extreme.

**"You have no temptations great enough to break my Son."** God spoke His challenge into Satan's mind.

**"Possibly not. But proving that may cost more than you will pay... I want the life of one of Emanuel's Disciples. I will either tempt the Disciple into betraying Emanuel, then killing himself in guilt; or I will possess him, and take his life by my will.**

The test was essential. God's answer resolute, **"Granted."**

**"And I will do this in the hours, just before he dies. So he dies with that pain heavy on his heart."**

**"I see."**

The deal was made.



Satan studied Emanuel and His Disciples, and observed that Emanuel seemed closest to John. Satan resolved to kill John.

But Emanuel was a Wager party. And he had not agreed to allow Satan to kill John.

Emanuel, the Son of God, who helped His Father create the universe, whom we call Jesus, agreed to symbolically enter a human body and die for mankind's sins. Emanuel knew of His Father's *Revelation Wagers* with Satan –Wagers that began 2000 years before Revelation was written. And John was the Disciple Emanuel pre-selected to transcribe His Revelation, which would be delivered to John roughly 60 years after Emanuel's human death. But if Satan were allowed to kill John, Emanuel's will would not be fulfilled. It is certain that Emanuel, who likely learned of John's death in His final hours, continued, and died on the cross, to fulfill His Father's will. But upon his human death, Emanuel demanded a time reversal, to redo the Messiah's story –under a new name: *Jesus*, to honor the new Timeline. And, with the new timeline, there would be a clear understanding: Satan could claim one of the Disciple's lives –any Disciple except John. So God, or Jesus, or both, executed the time reversal, to some number of days before Jesus' birth, and *Line 4* was born.<sup>3</sup>

Years later, Jesus told John about Line 2, where Satan murdered John. Thus, although John's name was still John on Line 4, when he wrote the Book of John, he would not call himself John, because he was not John: he was John B, or John 2, or John II... Certainly the same, but certainly different.

This story highlights the fact that God has willed it that (1) Jesus' (or Emanuel's) mind is not fully known to Him (as God allowed Satan to kill John, unaware that Emanuel had select John to write His and God's *Revelation*), and (2) God's mind is not fully known to Emanuel/Jesus (confirmed in places like Matthew 24:36, where Jesus tell the disciples, “**But of that day and hour, no one knows; no, not even the angels of Heaven, but My Father only**”). Further, in my book *The Wagers*, we learn high ranking angels, and elite demons, like Satan, can also move outside of God and Jesus' *mind-view*.<sup>4</sup> In all of this, God seems to be showing us that He gives higher spiritual entities much more freedom than we humans understand.

In sum, Emanuel and the Disciples lived on Line 2; but when Emanuel died, and He and/or God reversed time, that act created Line 3, and humanity was restored or reborn, on Line 4.

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<sup>3</sup> Although in some places in this book, I may say *God executed the Line 3 reversal* (it's safest to attribute the impossible to God), I believe Emanuel executed the reversal. However, although God seems to give Jesus/Emanuel unlimited freedom, I believe executing a reversal -ending the timeline of a planet's dominant species- would require God's consent, and possibly Natas'.

<sup>4</sup> *Mind-view* refers to the standard condition where God and/or Jesus can see an entity and read his/her mind. During the Wagers, Satan was permitted to move out of God's mind-view, but Jesus had constant access to Satan's thoughts and whereabouts. Thus, there is no known precedent of being out of both God and Jesus' mind-view.

#### LINE 4

Line 4 runs from the re-birth of Jesus to God punishing Satan for stealing Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe's crown, in 1888.<sup>5</sup> For Satan's punishment, God replaced John D Rockefeller III, the originally planned human beast of Revelation 13:18, with John W Gardner. This change was Earth's first *phantom* timeline change: God foretold, in Revelation's coded verses, of a future with Rockefeller as the beast, but 36 years before that future arrived, God changed the beast, by redirecting Satan's attention (for details, see STSN or *The Wagers*). This change left Revelation 11:12, 13, and 19 without a reference beast –making those verses much harder to solve. But defying human logic, as God can, the unfulfilled verses made discovering the 7 human timelines possible. [Note: We can confirm the Beast was changed on Line 4 into 5, and not on Line 7, because later the evidence will show that Gardner was the Line 5 human Beast.]<sup>6</sup>

I'm almost certain that with the Line 3 reversal into Line 4, God reversed time to the moments just before Emanuel's rebirth as Jesus, when God's angel appears to Joseph and instructs him to name the baby Jesus, in Matthew 1:21: **"And she will bring forth a child, and you shall call his name Jesus, for He will save His people from their sins."** And to honor the Savior, Emanuel, just two verses later, Matthew 1:23 reminds us of the Prophecy of Emanuel's coming: *"Behold, a virgin shall be with child, and bear a Son, and they shall call His name Emanuel, which is translated, 'God with us.'"*

#### **Elijah to Come Before Emanuel –But Elijah could be Erased**

Isaiah 7:14 first tells us of the coming of Emanuel. Two or three centuries later, in Malachi, the final book of the Old Testament, in the second to last verse, 4:5, God tells us His prophet Elijah will come before Emanuel.

Behold, I will send you Elijah the prophet,  
Before the great and dreadful day of the Lord

But one verse later, 4:6, the final verse of the Old Testament, God hints that Elijah could be erased, and warns He will strike the Earth with a curse if Elijah does not come.

*And he will turn the hearts of the fathers to the children,  
And the hearts of the children to their fathers,  
**Lest I come and strike the Earth with a curse.***

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<sup>5</sup> Stealing Nuestra's crown occurred on Line 4, but the moment God completed the beast change, Line 5 was created.

<sup>6</sup> I should point out, (1) in *Revelation 2: The Solutions*, I revealed the identity of Revelation's first human beast: John Gardner (I was able to do this because Gardner's past intersected frequently with mine; this personal knowledge was a solution requirement, "...Let him who hath understanding count the number of the beast..."), but (2) using only the Bible, I also found the originally prophesied beast: JD Rockefeller III. The point? The Bible is sufficient, and provides secondary paths to solutions.

## Satan Erases Elijah –On Line 4

In Matthew 17:1, Jesus Transfigures before His Disciples, bursting with light. Two verses later, at 17:3, still in the Transfiguration, Jesus shares with the disciples a vision of Himself, standing with Moses and Elijah, glorified in the light of God. Peter is so impressed with Moses and Elijah that he suggests he and the Disciples make three tabernacles, “...one for You, one for Moses, and one for Elijah” (17:4). The next verse, 17:5, God appears in a bright cloud overhead, and verifies all that was witnessed, by telling the disciples, **“This is my beloved Son, in Whom I am well pleased.”**

Five verses later, 17:10, certain that Jesus is the Son of God, the disciples still wonder why Elijah did not come before Jesus, as Prophesied in Malachi 4:5 and 6.

**MYSTERY:** Answering the disciples’ question, Jesus explains (Matthew 17:12): **“Elijah has come already, and they [the people] did not know him, but did to him whatever they wished.”** How can this be? In 17:3 and 4, we witnessed Elijah standing in Jesus’ glorifying light; so impressive was Elijah that Peter suggested the disciples build three tabernacles. **So how can it be that Elijah is so venerated as to stand before Jesus, with Moses, yet Jesus says that the people “...did not know him, but did to him whatever they wished”** (meaning they treated him disrespectfully)?

**SOLUTION:** The reason for this conflict is: Elijah came and fulfilled God’s prophecy on Line 2, and earned his honor and glory before Emanuel’s crucifixion and death. However, with the Line 3 reversal, once Line 4 began, Satan knew who Elijah was on Line 4. Therefore, Satan was able to use his broad abilities to influence many, many minds at once, to influence public opinion, and to get people to reject and doubt Elijah at every opportunity; eventually reducing Elijah, on Line 4, to a laughingstock.

**A New MYSTERY Emerges from The Previous Solution.** The previous solution indicates Satan recognized Elijah on Line 4. This means God and Jesus allowed Satan to have some memories of Line 2. God could allow people to recall as much of their previous lives as He wills; but I suspect He would not tend to interfere with memories; although, occasionally, some people could have strange crossover memories from a prior line. But, as we see later, on Line 7, God allowed Satan to remember every detail of Line 5; yet, at the time that I wrote this book, spring 2026, Satan firmly believed humanity was only on *line B* (Line 2). Thus, a new mystery...

**MYSTERY: *Why would God give Satan complete recall of Line 5, but very little recall of Line 2?*** This Mystery has at least 3 solutions:

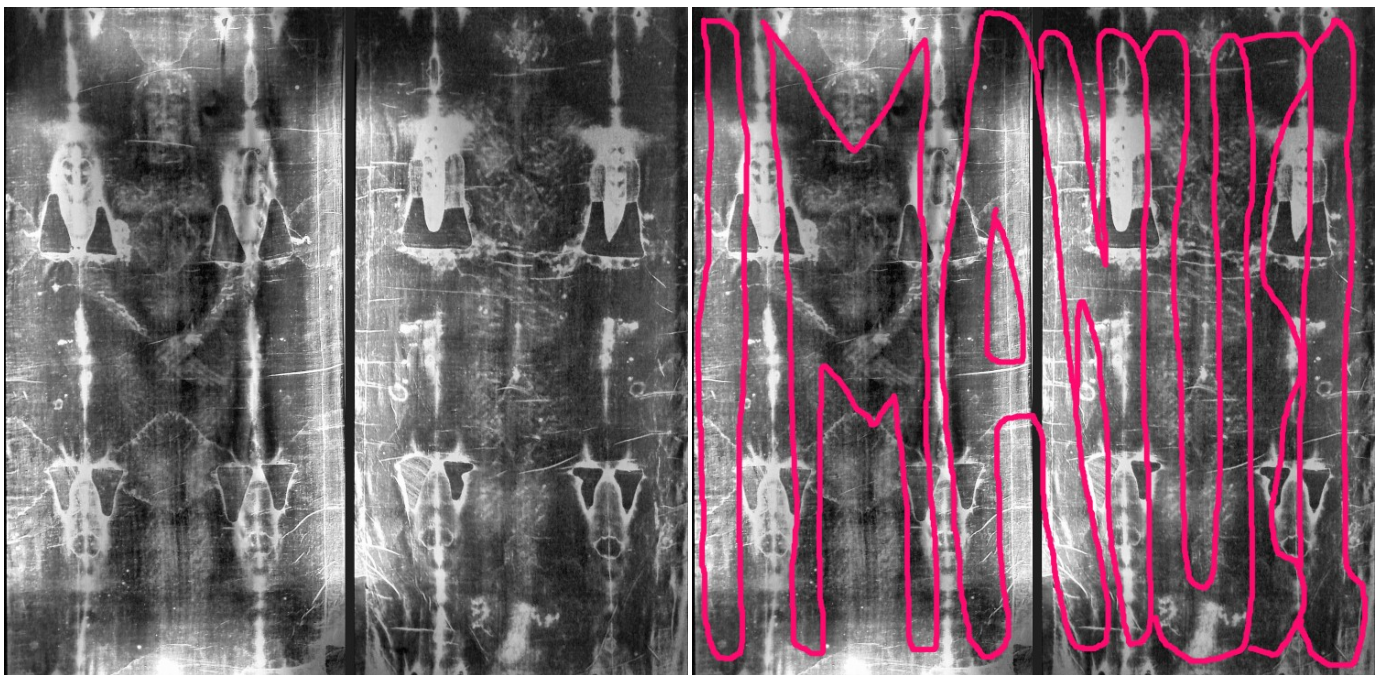
**SOLUTION #1:** through my books on the Wagers, I’ve learned Satan often commits flagrant rule violations, when the stakes are high; forcing God to impose punishment (God seems to ignore most of Satan’s compulsive cheating; but intervenes when the offense goes too far). Thus, my suspicion is that upon killing John, Satan may

have had minions and demons desecrate John's body, which God would never permit. Thus, unable to erase the offense, God erased Satan's memories of the end of Line 2.

**SOLUTION #2:** God may have also allowed Satan to remember Elijah's face to expose Satan's intellectual flaws. Satan's behavior suggests he believes he is smarter than any being in the universe; but constantly ignores evidence of his intellectual limits. Thus, Satan never wondered how he knew Elijah's face before he encountered the man.

**SOLUTION #3:** Perhaps the foremost reason God punished Satan, by erasing his memories of Line 2 (but letting him keep the memory of Elijah's face), was to provide evidence that God knew what Satan's first move would be on Line 4 –trying to erase Elijah. Thus, God erased Satan's memories of Line 2, but gave him a memory of the face of the first man he erased from history: Elijah. And God knew the person to reveal this would be the *last* person Satan would try to erase, in his last days on Earth: me.

- **SOLUTION:** As God is so ethical, it is also possible, even probable, that since He did not tell Satan of Emanuel's time reversal, He imposed a firm penalty against Himself. And, as Line 4 began, He revealed to Satan who Elijah and the Virgin Mary were; so Satan could try, respectively, to erase one, and weaken the other's moral integrity.



In the first versions of my mini-book, *The Shroud of God*, I assumed the Shroud was an image of Jesus, which God gave the world, a few decades after Jesus' death, in 77 AD. However, the name in the Shroud (above, right), *Immanuel*, suggests the Shroud is a likeness of Emanuel (or *Immanuel*, in Greek –the new language of the New Testament; the Old Testament had been written in Hebrew). The spelling, *Immanuel*, may be God observing that the Hebrew spelling of Emanuel has 6 letters and one *M*; while the Spanish, Portuguese, German languages use one *M* and 7 letters (*Emanuel*): but the Greek and English spellings add an extra *M*, and 8 letters. [NOTE: You will find a much larger image outlining of Immanuel's name, in the *Notes* section, page 253, an enlargement of The Shroud negative is provided on page 255.]



## **A Hidden New Testament Vision of Emanuel and Elijah,**

### **On Line 2: “*Why Have You Forsaken Me?*”**

It would be easy to make an argument that Mathew 27:46 is the most moving verse in the Bible –even if we don’t fully understand what’s happening in the scene. In His final moments, dying on the Cross, the Messiah cries out at his Father, “**My God, My God, why have you forsaken Me?**”

Over the years, I’ve heard several theories about why Jesus says these words in his final moments. The theory I’ve heard most often is that, in Jesus’ final moments, all of the world’s sins fall upon Him, and God turns away from the sight of the terrible sins. Feeling abandoned, Jesus responds, “**My God, My God, why have you forsaken Me?**”

That theory has some merit. But, in my book, the theory is disrespectful to God. God and Jesus observe all of our sins, and all sins around the universe. They see unthinkable crimes, I could never force myself to witness. But They have committed themselves to observe every offense and success, to determine how deep in Gehenna, or how high in Heaven each soul belongs. So, after seeing the universe’s worst crimes, for an eternity, according to the theory, God lacked the heart to witness His Son’s final moments, because Earth’s sins were more than He could bear? It doesn’t stand up.

Here’s what I believe happened... First let’s review a passage, then I’ll explain what happened in the Solution. The four verse passage I’m interested in is Matthew 27:46, 47, 48 and 49, which read:

- 46. And about the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice, saying, “**Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani,**” that is: “**My God, My God, why have you forsaken me?**”
- 47. Some of those who stood there, when they heard that said, “This man is calling for Elijah!”
- 48. Immediately one of them ran and took a sponge, filled it with sour wine and put it on a reed, and gave it to him to drink.
- 49. The rest said, “Let him alone; let us see if Elijah will come save him.”

#### **MYSTERY: What is this scene about?**

**Solution:** This scene is a reenactment of Emanuel’s final moments on the Cross, on Line 2. The scene starts with Jesus, in Timeline 4, repeating Emanuel’s final words. The scene then shifts to Timeline 2, for verses 27:47, 48 and 49. God and Jesus, clearly, would have agreed to do this some time earlier, to provide evidence of Line 2, and Emanuel’s death there, and Their commitment not to forget any souls there.

Here’s the set up... Without Emanuel’s knowledge or permission, God agreed to allow Satan to kill one Disciple. Satan chose Emanuel’s favorite Disciple, John –whom Emanuel chose to deliver His Revelation, roughly 60 years in the future. But just before Emanuel’ death on the Cross, He learned of John’s death. Emanuel is/was omniscient,

and, like His Father, knew/knows all Events far into the future (with the exception of a few events God may will to secrecy). John was not expected to die. Thus, Emanuel knew either God -or Satan Wagering with God- killed John. Feeling betrayed, and grieving for His lost friend, Emanuel cried out, **“My God, My God, why have you forsaken me?”**

It is almost certain that at that moment, Emanuel had already resolved He would insist on reversing time to re-run his life on Earth –next time with the name Jesus, or whatever name God selected, with the clear understanding that John could not be killed. Other than this one sentence, out of respect for His Father, Emanuel would not further express difference or disagreement with His Father in public. This stands as an example of how children, even adult children, should revere their parents.

We know the subsequent verses, Matthew 27:47-49 are set on Line 2, because the people know Elijah (*The rest said, “Let him alone; let us see if Elijah will come save him”*; Matt 27:49). Those verses could only occur in Emanuel’s life on Line 2, because, as Jesus explained, on Line 4, in Matthew 17:12, Elijah came and the people of Judea and Galilee did not recognize him, and treated him disrespectfully. Thus, God used Matthew 27:46-49 to confirm timelines 3 and 4, and reveal Emanuel’s great character, and show Elijah was known and widely respected on Line 2. The fact that someone shows mercy to Emanuel in 27:48, and gives him a sip of sour wine, immediately after Elijah’s name is uttered, speaks to Elijah’s great stature on Line 2.

- Matthew 27: 47, 48 and 49 are set on a different timeline than the rest of the Book. Revelation, Chapter 18, is entirely set in Line 5. But for Revelation, this isn’t surprising, as Revelation contains passages set on every timeline (Emanuel’s Line 3 death and reversal to Line 4 are expressed in Revelation 5:6; I’ll elaborate in a Rev 2 update). Genesis, Chapter 1, begins before there is a human timeline, but ends when Line 1 begins; Line 2 begins at Genesis 3:1, when the Serpent appears.

- Because Revelation 11:12, 13 and 19 refer to a timeline entity that never came to exist, it can be said that Revelation contains verses set on **8 timelines**: 5 conventional lines, 2 reversals, and 1 phantom line.



**MYSTERY: How do we know God erased almost all of Satan’s memories of Emanuel’s life and times on Line 2?**

**SOLUTION:** We know this because Satan does not remember killing John (a great evil triumph); we also know this because, as you will learn in chapter 2, Satan thinks we are currently on line B (Line 2). The evidence indicates the only memories Satan had/has of Emanuel’s life on Line 2 was/is knowledge of Elijah’s face, and possibly knowledge of the Virgin Mary’s face.

## The Two Mother's of God

In reading this section, readers should understand the Virgin Mary is not Emanuel's/Jesus' true mother. Rather, Mary was His representational mother. Emanuel/Jesus helped His Father create the universe, and had existed for untold billions of years before Mary's birth.

When a time reversal happens, life in the new timeline is worse. This is because in the second run Satan has knowledge of the prior line, and remembers his enemies, and attacks them pre-emptively and relentlessly. Thus, in the change from Line 2 to 4, we see Satan's negative impact on the world, in the fact that Elijah is erased on Line 4.

Although Emmanuel and Jesus are the same Entity, God gave Him different names on different timelines –likely to model good record-keeping habits for humans. But timeline reversals create problems and mysteries far greater than unreliable records. Here's an example...

In the internationally recognized story of the Virgin Mary and Juan Diego, in resurrected spiritual form, the Virgin Mary famously tells Juan Diego she is “the mother of the very true diety” (since the West has corrupted this story, the exact words vary, from version to version; but in all versions I have seen, Mary does not say Jesus' name). In these relatively traditional stories, Mary is always identified as a virgin, and many of these accounts assert Mary remained a virgin throughout her life on Earth. HOWEVER, going against this, in the Bible, Matthew 1:24 and 25, explain an important detail about Mary and her husband Joseph, stating: (24) *Then Joseph, being aroused from sleep, did as the angel of the Lord commanded him and took to him his wife, (25) and did not **know her until** she had brought forth her first born Son. And he called His name Jesus.”*<sup>7</sup>

Thus, on Jesus' timeline, 4, His representational mother remained a virgin until He was born, then consummated her relationship with her human husband, Joseph.

**MYSTERY: The Mary that appeared to Juan Diego remained a virgin forever, but the Bible suggests Mary did not remain a virgin. How can this conflict stand?**

**SOLUTION:** The Virgin Mary/Guadalupe who appeared to Juan Diego was the Earth mother of Emanuel the Savior, on Line 2 (this is the reason she does not say Jesus' name –because *her* Son was named Emanuel). On Line 2, Mary remained a virgin for the duration of her human life. Because she remained a virgin, to honor God, but her Line 4 incarnation did not (yet, the Line 4 version of Mary is revered as the true mother of the Messiah) the Virgin Mary of Line 2 justifiably believes she should have a church built to honor her life, which was erased from history when God and Emanuel reversed time. The fact that on Line 4 Mary was physically intimate with Joseph is an example of Satan degrading life on the new timeline.

The images to the right and below are *image outlinings* from the Shroud of Turin (more about *outlinings* in Part IV of this chapter). While writing this section, I found the words *Line 2*, *3*, and *4* in the image. The *3* is poorly formed, but the *2* and *4* are almost perfect; as if saying Emanuel (Line 2) and Jesus (Line 4) are the same. However, the 2 is taller than the 4. Thus, I believe God is confirming the image is a likeness of Emanuel, from Line 2.
