- Partner schools completed 2 terms of training

- 3 sister school partnerships implemented

## CHALLENGES

- We had to make the difficult decision to pause teacher training operations because of a lack of revenue. This led to us letting go of our full-time teacher training staff.
- Sister School Partnership projects are difficult to share effectively through google drive.
- Several young women in our partner schools were falling behind in studies because of a lack of access to menstrual health education and products.
- Our partner schools did not have access to leveled reader books to assess student's reading levels.

## GROWTH

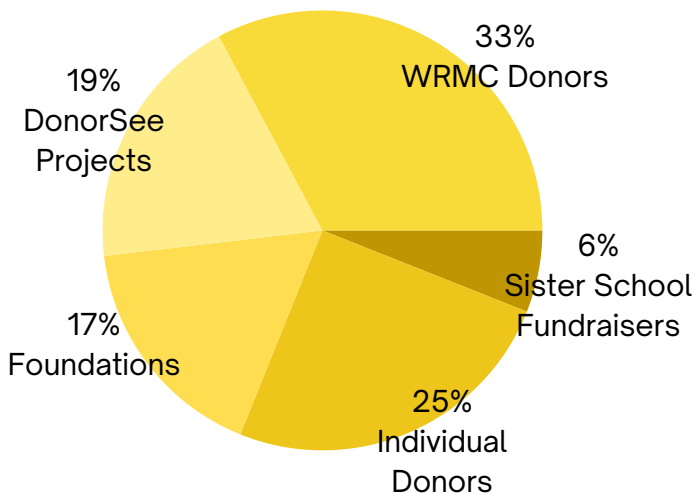
- We have restructured our teacher training program to work with professional teacher training contractors rather than full-time employees. This allows us to hire trainers when funding is available.
- We have trained sister school participants on the use of google drive and appointed head teachers over the partnership.
- With the help of our partners at Start From Ghana Foundation, we were able to implement the Duafe Sisterhood Program in three locations.
- Through donations on our DonorSee platform, we were able to purchase several leveled reading books to our partner schools from a local book publishing company.

## GOALS

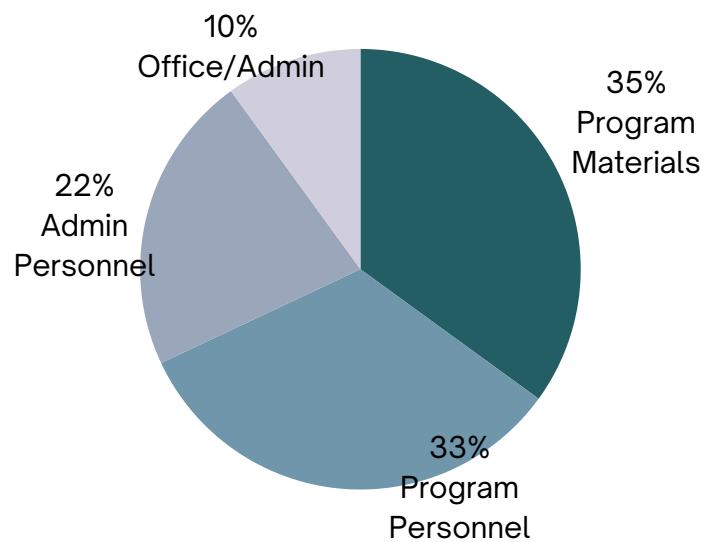
- Launch Empowering School Program. OneSeed will offer customized teacher development to higher-income schools who will pay a donation fee in return. This fee will enable us to provide free teacher development to our low-income partner schools.
- Design a software that enables Sister Schools to share projects easier as well as share fundraising progress with their communities.
- Bring the Duafe Sisterhood program to six locations including communities outside Accra, training local women leaders with the tools they need to help fight against period poverty.
- Work in partnership with universities, schools, and local book publisher to provide leveled reading intervention books and training to partner schools.
