

THE PRIMARY IS COMING ON TUESDAY APRIL 23

2024 is a pivotal year for the United States of America and it is imperative that we reelect President Joe Biden and have a Democratic majority in both the US Senate and the US House of Representatives. STATE REPRESENTATIVE HEATHER BOYD UPDATE

State Representative Heather Boyd has been busy working for us in Harrisburg and here in Delco. In Harrisburg, she obtained funding for local stormwater infrastructure, including \$213,563 for Aldan. She has been working on legislation to improve Pennsylvanians' access to healthcare and pushing for the state budget to include increased funding for our public schools.

Around the district, Rep. Boyd regularly holds Property Tax and Rent Rebate Program clinics to help eligible older and/or disabled adults get the relief they are entitled to. She has also recently held a FAFSA workshop and a shredding event, as well as co-hosting Aldan's Black History Month Celebration.
