- work one on one with a teacher
- practice and generalize skills such as dictation, and writing through relevant and meaningful activities

10:15AM - 10:45AM – MATH BREAK/SMALL GROUP

- learn about new concepts in the content areas of math
- participate in activities/games guided by the teacher
- extend their learning experiences by engaging in activities through technology
- cooperate with a classmate or in a small group
- work one on one with a teacher
- practice and generalize skills such as counting and problem solving through relevant and meaningful activities

10:45AM - 11:15AM – ART BREAK / MUSIC & MOVEMENT

Art will help children:

- Develops creative thinking
- Provides a means of communication and self-expression
- Serves as an emotional release, Builds confidence, and Generates joy
- Increases self-understanding
- Heightens aesthetic awareness and sensitivity
- Enhances the ability to visualize
- Provides problem-solving/decision-making opportunities
- Develops appreciation for the individuality of others
- Leads to the integration of the individual
- Serves as a balance to academic activities
- Aids physical coordination
- Develops work habits and a sense of responsibility
