Voodoo Acoustics has recently introduced its new Iso Vent subwoofer, the VIV-210T. Intended for applications where space is a major concern, the VIV-210T is a super-slim dual 10" design, with one of its dimensions reduced to only seven inches. Characteristics and performance are almost identical to Voodoo's well-known VIV-210 "Boris" model, and has extended deep bass with moderately high efficiency in a very small box.

Suggested retail price of the VIV-210T is \$449.

The Derringer 2 Security System from Vehicle Security Electronics has a 2-button RF-Remote controlled system. The system features passive or active arming with valet mode, remote panic, starter inhibit relay, diagnostics mode, hood and trunk protection and intrusion zone history. Optional features include door

lock/unlock outputs, colored transmitters, and multiple auxiliary remote function outputs. Suggested retail price of the Derringer 2 is \$299 to \$349 installed.

Loud and *Clarion*

Clarion Car Audio has recently introduced the 5870 CD AM/FM tuner. The new unit comes with a changer control and has eight times oversampling, dual "Bitstream" DACs, three-beam laser tracking and full logic controls. The 5870 is capable of playing 3" discs without an adaptor, and has electronic volume/bass/treble/balance/fader control. The unit features a four-channel gold RCA line level output, infrared remote control, din removable chassis, and LCD multi-mode display.

Suggested retail price of the 5870 is \$649.95.
