BIOGRAPHY

Born in 1978 in Maricao, Puerto Rico, Fabián Detrés began his studies at the Escuela de Artes Plásticas de Puerto Rico (E.A.P.) at the age of 17. In 2001, he graduated Summa Cum Laude with a B.F.A. in Visual Arts, specializing in Painting, and received the Dr. José R. Oliver medal for academic excellence. During his studies, he was awarded second place in the 1998 Annual Student Exhibition.

In 2000 and 2001, he received scholarships from the Randy Barceló Foundation, recognizing his exceptional contributions to painting. In 2009, he was awarded scholarships from the Karrvaz Foundation and III Millennium Scholarships, enabling him to conduct artistic projects in

Albacete, Spain.

Following Hurricane María in 2017, Detrés paused his artistic career and relocated to the United States, working in the petroleum industry. He resumed his career in 2020 with a solo exhibition, 42 and Reset. Throughout his career, Detrés has been involved in numerous local and international projects, including the Archivo Digital Histórico del Pueblo de Maricao.

ARTIST STATEMENT

My work explores the complexities of the human psyche, our fragile behaviors, and the subjectivity of perception. Series like Philosopher's Stone, Lunar Circus, and Light and Reflections reflect this introspective and symbolic approach. My philosophy emphasizes that technique and medium should enhance the conceptual narrative, allowing for a fluid and versatile body of work.

The devastation of Hurricane María in 2017 deeply

impacted Puerto Rico and marked a shift in my art, making it more empathic. Migration, a central theme in my recent series, is portrayed as a historical constant and a driver of human progress and evolution. My latest work, La Buena Fortuna, embodies themes of resilience and prosperity, inviting the viewer to reflect on the human condition and transformative potential of art.
