

# DISMANTLING

Rotate and unscrew the lightsaber body



Unscrew the back screws of the handle



Push the switch button from the handle surface into the infrastructure



Pull down the inner structure




## CHARGING DIAGRAM

For models with an external chargingport, please use the charging cableprovided by the merchant to plug in andcharge.



For models with built-in chargingport, please unscrew the saber pommelor handle, and then use the chargingcable provided by the merchant to plugin and charge.



For models without a charging port, please unscrew the saber handle, thentake out the battery and use the chargingbox provided by the merchant to charge.

# Single Button Control

Standby mode	Button Operation	
Switch pixel number	Top the button 3 times when power off .	
Enter standby mode	Hold the button until the button light is on.	
Enter boot status	Tap the button after enter standby mode.	
Volume adjust	Hold the button until the breath light flashes once then release.	
Switch boot effect	Hold the button until the breath light flashes bylice then release.	
Switch blade effect	Hold the button until the breath light flashes Three times then release.	
Switch sound fonts	Hold the button until the breath light flashes Four times then release.	
Power off	Hold the button until the breathing light is off.	
Power saving mode	No operation for 10 minutes

Lock-up	Hold the button until the breath light flashes once then release.

# 2 Button Control

When buttons are distributed up and down: Upper button is PWR button-lower button is AUX button. When the buttons are distributed left and right: left button is PWR button-right button is AUX button.

Standby mode	Button Operation	
Switch pixel number	Tap the PWR button 3 times when power off	
Enter standby mode	Hold the PWR until hearing the prompt sound "power on"	
Enter boot status	Tap the PWR after enter standby mode.	
Switch sound fonts	Tap the AUX.	
Enter/Exit Volume adjust Mode	Hold the PWR and AUX at the same time until hear the beep then release it.	
After Enter volume adjust Mode	Tap the PWR button to increase the volume. Tap the AUX button to decrease the volume.	
Switching boot effect	Hold the PWR button until hear the beep then release it.	
Switch blade effect	Hold the AUX button until hear the beep then release it.	
Power off	Tap the AUX button 3 times.	
Power saving mode	No operation for 10 minutes.

- \*Please fully charge before operation.
- \*Please use a SV1A power adapter.
- Please keep small accessories safe and keep them out of reach of children to prevent them from accidentally swallowing.
- \*Please notice the anode and cathode of the battery.
- Please use this product within the temperature range of 0C-35C and store.
   It in the range of -20C+45C.
- Don't expose the battery to high temperatures or heat generating products, such as surlight, heaters, microwaves, ovens, or water heaters.
   Overheating the battery may cause an explosion.
- •Don't throw batteries into fire. It is prohibited to disassemble, drop, squeeze or modify batteries. ## ▶ FAQ

#### The saber has no sound

Please confirm whether it is in mute mode, and you can adjust volume mode, or reinstall the battery.

#### The blade is easy to loosen

Make sure that the screws that secure the blade are tightened. In addition, it is normal for the screws and the blade to loosen during the fight. You can change the fixed position of the screw and tighten the screw.

#### Saber cannot be turned on

Please charge the saber first to make sure it is fully charged. If it still can't be solved, please remove the battery and reinstall it (pay attention to the positive and negative poles), and make sure the battery are contact well.

## WARRANTY

The product has a one-year warranty period.

Warranty covers original products and accessories that have not been modified.

Includes: light saber handle, electronic internal structure, and light saber blade.
