# YOSEMITE MUST-SEES

### MIST TRAIL

Somewhere over the rainbow... climb up this beautiful nature made staircase to reach Vernal Falls! You will see where the trail gets its name, as you get misted directly from the source. (At certain times of the year, *mist* is an understatement.)

Stay here for a photo op, or continue your trek up to the top of Vernal Falls. This is the perfect time to get out a snack and rest.

## LODGING

Once you have finished with your day of fun, it is time to turn in for the night. One of the great places to stay in the Park is The Redwoods in Yosemite. Complete with over 120 cabins only 4.5 miles from the South entrance. Immersed in nature you will find roaring waterfalls and the swinging Wawona Bridge on site.

If you would like to stay in a high-end lodge with plenty of amenities for the family, Tenaya Lodge is for you!
Located just outside of the Park, the Tenaya Lodge is the perfect place to relax after a day of exploring Yosemite.

With 5 spa tubs, a fitness center, an indoor pool, archery as well as yoga classes, this is the definition of *glamping*.

### **TRAILS**

Into hiking? Pro or purely for enjoyment? Yosemite has a bunch and at all levels. Bridalveil Falls and Lower Yosemite Falls range on the easier side. Whereas Vernal Fall, Nevada Fall, and Snow Creek Trail are strenuous. Also, following this category is the famous Half Dome. To hike this trail, you must have a permit to use the cables. The Park also accommodates those who enjoy horseback riding.

### **TUNNEL VIEW**

Finally, the highlight of Yosemite, Tunnel View! Driving through the Wawona Tunnel, you will be in awe as you exit and see the Valley Floor of Yosemite. The natural beauty of the Park is what draws you back to it again and again, finding more unique treasures to explore next time.
