

Vision of The NEW Guardians

We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all People are created equal, that they are endowed by God with certain unalienable Rights, that among these are Life, Freedom, the Fulfillment of Purpose and the Enjoyment of these.—That to secure and protect these rights, Governments are instituted among Citizens, deriving their just powers from the consent of the governed,—That whenever any Leaders become destructive of these ends, or Government institutions become harmful to the People, it is the Right of the People to alter the arrangement or to remove them, and to install New Guardians, whose foundation is laid on such principles of accountability and limited powers, as to the People shall seem most likely to effect the People's Safety and Enjoyment. Prudence, indeed, will dictate that Governments long established should not be changed for light and transient causes; and accordingly, all experience has shown, that mankind is more disposed to suffer, while evils are sufferable, than to right themselves by abolishing the forms to which they are accustomed. But when a long train of abuses and control, pursuing invariably the same Object results in a design to reduce them to be under absolute Tyranny, it is the People's right, it is their duty, to throw off such corrupt and tyrannical Government, and to provide New Guardians for their future security.
