Getting to Camp Burton

Camp Burton is on Vashon Island, which can be accessed by ferry. If you're driving in, please see the following ferry schedules: Fauntleroy (So. Seattle) to Vashon, Point Defiance to Tahlehquah (Vashon) or scan the QR Codes. If you're flying in from out of state to join us, please provide your flight information to Rev. Paul Schneider at the Evergreen Office (paul@ea-abc.org or by phone at 253-859-2226 x1) as he will be coordinating carpools to get people to and from the camp. If you want to rent a car to get around, you certainly can, and please let Rev. Paul know. That said, we try to make it unnecessary for anyone to incur this extra expense.



Linens, Towels, Sleeping Arrangements

Camp Burton no longer provides linens for free for all guests of the Retreat Center. Therefore we are asking anyone who can (those not flying in) to bring their own bedding and towels. If you are flying in, we will be glad to provide a linen set. We will cover these costs, however, if you have the ability to cover the cost of the linens (\$15), that would be helpful. Make sure that when you register if you need linens that you indicate that you need them, and if you are able to help offset the cost. Unlike previous years, because of the number of people attending we are not able to ensure specific roommates so as to maximize space in the Retreat Center.

Paying for the Retreat

In previous years, Evergreen has covered the cost of the leadership retreat in full. This worked well to encourage participation when we only had 20 people, but we are expecting over 70 people in person and probably more than 20 people online this year. The costs for just the housing and the meals is more than \$150 per person, before we start taking into account our other costs. Therefore we are asking that those individuals or congregations who are able consider paying \$100 towards the in person retreat, and \$50 towards the online retreat. Also, if you or your congregation, have the financial wherewithal to provide a scholarship towards someone else, it would be greatly appreciated. As noted above, there is also an option to cover the costs of linens if you're covering the cost of online attendance.
