One premier academy started to form, and now, in its fourth year, we have more than 100 players spanning across 8 age groups.




2020 - 2021

The original concept of our academy, known as Premier Liga FC, played a crucial role in shaping our journey to where we stand today.



To ensure every player has a comfortable and safe week, please pack for both sunny and wet conditions daily. Essentials include a large, labeled water bottle (refill stations provided), a packed lunch and two healthy snacks, and necessary medication (clearly labeled and given directly to the Head Coach at drop-off with clear instructions). For hot weather, players must wear sunscreen (applied before arrival), a hat, and athletic clothing. For rain, please include a waterproof jacket and a spare change of clothes in a separate bag, as we play rain or shine!

- Submit payment via Bank Transfer or Cash.

After registration, a confirmation email will provide the camp fee and banking details.

• Transfer within 24 hours using the player's name and camp week as reference. Send a screenshot or email confirmation to finalize the spot.

Cash

• Bring the exact fee in a sealed envelope with the player's name on the first day before the camp begins and be advised that your booking is not confirmed until payment is received
