Dear DuPage Volunteers & Donors:

"Volunteering is powerful."

Linda, a new volunteer committee member, said recently at a meeting. It stopped me immediately and I took a second to absorb the simple, yet profound, truth of that statement. It resonates for anyone who has volunteered.

Since I heard it, I've reflected on the power of volunteerism and considered it in the context of my own volunteer experience. When I was in high school, I was one of a handful of kids who studied German for four years. Our German teacher, Frau Tymoszenko, must have believed in giving back because she scheduled a few volunteer field trips to the German nursing home for us to sing Christmas carols in German to the residents of the home. All these years later, I haven't forgotten how much joy it brought to the residents to hear us high-schoolers sing "Stille Nacht, Heilige Nacht," and can today appreciate how those songs probably brought back fond memories of their upbringing in Germany.

In another example, I was in my 30s when I attended the annual picnic for our cultural association with my parents. I was disappointed because it felt like I was the only "young" person there. I went up to some elders who organized the event and asked, "Where are all the young people?" They came right back and challenged me, "We need your help to get them to attend our events." This led to me starting a youth committee and eventually to serving on the board. During that time, we were able to get many younger people involved, including my brother. We also hosted a national conference to celebrate our heritage, where my brother met his now wife; and as life goes, they have two sons. In my case, volunteering resulted in some wonderful outcomes and led to the blessings that nephews can bring. It is also a source of pride to know that many of those (now not as young) people we engaged continue to volunteer with that organization and continue to honor our cultural traditions.

These personal examples are shared to underscore the power of volunteering as a path available to all. Over the years, I have been fortunate to have met countless volunteers throughout DuPage County from all walks of life. This is a composite of their powerful volunteer story.

You are female. He is Asian. I am a stay-at-home parent.

You are an electrician. She is a lawyer. We are student volunteers.

I appreciate networking when I volunteer.

They volunteered once through a work event.

She has volunteered every week for the past nine

We volunteer at our church, mosque, temple and synagogue.

Volunteering reduces your stress.

They remember what their parents taught them through family volunteer experiences.

You believe in volunteering today because you were a product of a broken family, living in multiple foster homes and managed to grow up to have a great job and a happy family; but you never forgot how many volunteers and kind people you met along the way. To this day, your kids do not know your true story but know their dad believes in giving back.

Volunteering makes you HAPPY.

Volunteering connects you to COMMUNITY.

Volunteering helped you discover your PURPOSE.

Volunteering is **POWERFUL**.

Our deep gratitude to all and we hope everyone will find the power of volunteering in the pages of this guide.


