

Does Tractor warranty

cover windscreen or Glass repairs?

If you have a new Tractor protected by the manufacturer's warranty, this 'bumper-to-bumper' protection is likely to protect your windows and windshield only if the fault can be attributed to a manufacturing defect. An independent inspector will most likely be required to make an assessment on this.

If your windscreen was chipped by an external object – and this is $\underline{\text{very common}}$ – a windshield warranty can help. These warranties typically protect all glass in the Tractor, including sunroofs and windows. Depending on the size and positioning of the damage, they can be used to either repair the damage or replace the Glass entirely.

When the tractor leaves our site and then delivered to you should check for any damage and send to <u>warrany@nicolasmachery.com.au</u> photos of any defects before use.

If you damage after you should consult your insurance, you should make claim for glass damage .
