

How Many Spirits Are There?

Sometimes things can be a little disturbing inside modern Christianity. They often don't agree on much. If you don't know it yet, the scholars argue about a lot, including their chief doctrines. With just a little research you can easily determine that there are "many spirits" floating around that don't seem to be from Isaiah 11. So how do you know what the right spirit is? **Ephesians 4** makes it plain and simple: **ONE SPIRIT**. **It's baffling how much arguing there is over the nature of god, and the demand of every Christian to bow to the "Chief Doctrine" or be labeled a bad spirit. Who cares if the doctrine is a "Tradition of Men"?—just bow down now ~~brown cow~~ (black sheep)!**

Have you ever seen a Christian dismiss someone for having trouble understanding the Trinity Doctrine? Trinity is not in John 3.16 nor Luke 1.35! The Trinity Doctrine isn't in a single salutation of the New Testament

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This is an odd thing to observe, for in one moment they proclaim someone else not to have "the spirit" of understanding, while they themselves teach that the Trinity is a Mystery of the spirit. Unbelievable!

Simultaneously Disturbing and Fascinating Newsleak Times

So let's put what we can into perspective and take a shot at seeing if we can figure out what's wrong. And while we seek, remember that we are trying to unravel World History, so this could be a little difficult to grasp. Just try to see through deception...and that glass darkly!

Where is He that put His Holy Spirit within them?

Think about this very carefully: The term Holy Spirit **Only** shows up in the “Old Testament” three times: Once in David’s Psalm 51, written to Elohim, following his sins with Bathsheba. Christians know the verse well because they even have a song they sing that comes from the passage:

Create in me a clean heart, O God; and **renew a right spirit** within me. Cast me not away from *your* presence; and **take not your holy spirit** from me. Restore unto me the joy of *your* salvation; and uphold me with ***your* free spirit** [Who is David Psalming to?] → **Father God!**

The other two Holy Spirit phrases in the “Old Testament” appear in Isaiah 63 [understand this only refers to the exact term “holy spirit”]

The Ruwach Qodesh

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v10 But they rebelled, and vexed his holy Spirit: therefore he was turned to be their enemy, and he fought against them. **v11** Then he remembered the days of old, Moses, and his people, saying, Where is he that brought them up out of the sea with the shepherd of his flock? **where is he that put his holy Spirit within him?** [That’s a great question: **where is he?**]**v14 tells us** → **Spirit of the LORD** (יְהוָה הַרוּחַ Yahowah).

Where is he that put his holy spirit within them, **and who is he** who put his holy spirit within him? **Yahowah YHWH is the Holy One Most High Spirit!** Jesus is called the Hagios Gennao of the Most High: Luke 1.35

Isaiah 64.1 tells us where he is, and according to David, “he” would be the one that Christians call God the Father—Lord God (יְהוָה Elohiym).

So How Many Fathers Does Jesus Have? Mt1.18; Lk 1.35

To understand the reason for the question “How many Fathers does Jesus have?”, we need to understand something the ProphecyMachine.com calls Word Magick. Although profound, Word Magick is a simple concept. All someone has to do is repeat something over and over, and eventually it will be stuck in your brain, whether you want it there or not. This is the first part of the *incantation: repetition*. The *spell is spoken, or sung*. Even an outright lie with no truth repeated often enough becomes the truth for those that hear it enough; perception becomes reality even when it’s fake.

If the words are mixed with some truth, well then then a little leaven leavens the whole lump. Think Orwellian turning bad to ungood in Nineteen Eighty Four. Change one word or definition; change the whole meaning!

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In the case of some doctrines within Christianity, it’s more like a little lump in the big pile of leaven sometimes. We have maximum leaven-er-age in some cases. So what’s the return on investment when you have too much leaven-er-age? Well if you knead an answer to that? Look no further than the upper crust gone a-rye. You’re toast if you go against the grain of mainstream doctrine, even if the mantra crumbles under the weight of scripture. Sorry for the distraction and too much loafing around.

To answer the question

“How many Fathers does Jesus have”?

Let’s take a quick look at unnecessary word play!

We can exhort many points of this word manipulation (**in the English**) by King Jimmy 1611, but for the point of this insight, we will focus on the term(s) Holy Spirit vs. Holy Ghost. ProphecyMachine.com submits that this is intended confusion. **There is No Good Reason to translate the words Hagios Pneuma as Holy Spirit in one verse and Holy Ghost in another.**

This would only seem mysterious if one did not consider King James Freemasonic nature. However, if you understand who he was, and his role in increasing the confusion, by making slight unnecessary adjustments in the (English) text, then **King Jimmy's Adjustments** become simple evidence of the greater evil at play; confusion hath been sown on purpose!

And who and/or what is the Holy Spirit?

Jesus Fathered *by the Holy Spirit* (Matthew 1.18)

Jesus is Son of the Most High (Luke 1.30-35)

God is a Spirit (John 4.24) referring to The Father

The Eternal Spirit (Hebrews 9.14)

There is One Spirit (Ephesians 4.3-5)

The One Spirit is the Selfsame Spirit of God (1 Corinthians 12.1-14)

Jesus Says he is from God and God is a Spirit (John 4.23-26)

Jesus Addresses God as Holy Father in Prayer (John 17.11)

But we are somehow to believe that The Holy Spirit is Not the Father?

Jesus Offered Himself without Spot through the Eternal Spirit to heis (one) theos (god) (Matthew 19.17, Mark 10.18, Luke 18.19; John 17.3 the mono alethinos theos) the Living God (Hebrews 9.14). People argue if Holy Spirit is a power or entity; Both is the answer, when an exhaustive word study on spirit/holy spirit is done honestly; suggest G5319 exhaustive as well...sheds light on Hebrews 9.8 ← don't confuse the hagian as exactly the hagios pneuma.

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You think there is a Spirit that is more Holy than the Most-High Spirit of Father God?

Who is "HE" that will show who is "THE" Potentate? (I Timothy 6.13-16)

And Who is He that is the Monos Despotes Theos of Jude 1.4

God the Father is King Eternal Immortal Invisible Wise God which Jesus showed us for a path unto life everlasting. (I Timothy 1.17) Jesus is the Last Days Voice of God (Hebrews 1.1) Jesus is the Express Image of God's Confidence (Hebrews 1.3) character and Jesus is the Image of the Invisible God (Colossians 1.15) eikon 2 Cor 4.4 Jesus in the Appearance of God in the flesh as as Form of a Servant (Phil 2.6-7). It is the Father that makes Jesus the King of Kings in the Kingdom of God

We are also somehow supposed to believe that
the Father and the Son are CO-Equals?

JESUS WORDS Father is Greater than All (John 10.29) Father is Greater than Jesus (John 14.28). Then in John 10.30 Jesus proclaims “the unity”; like 1 John 1.3; 2 Cor 13.14.

And this is life eternal, that they might *know you the only true God*, and Jesus Christ, whom you have sent (John 17.3) Notice carefully that **Jesus also indirectly states the Holy Spirit is not God, unless the Holy Spirit is the Father,** i.e., Jesus forgot the Holy Spirit

And whatsoever *you* shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. (John 14.13)

Son Can do Nothing of Himself, Father God who has Life in Himself, Gives Jesus Life to have in himself (John 5:15-32 vs 26); Jesus does Nothing of Himself, but Only the Will of the Father who Sent Jesus (John 5:30)

In Jesus Christ (living tabernacle) Dwells all the fullness of the Godhead BODILY (Colossians 2:9)

Be Thinking King Jimmy Always Played Straight!

Three Different Words in the Greek Translated to the Same Word in the English?

Forasmuch then as we are the offspring of God, we ought not to think that the **Godhead** is like unto gold, or silver, or stone, graven by art and man's device. **G2304 theîos**, from G2316; godlike (neuter as noun, divinity):—divine, godhead. [Acts 17:29 KJV]

For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even his eternal power and **Godhead**; so that they are without excuse: **G2305 theiôtēs** from G2304; divinity (abstractly):—godhead. [Romans 1:20 KJV]

For in him dwells all the fulness of the **Godhead** bodily. **G2320 theótēs**, theh-ot'-ace; from G2316; divinity (abstractly):—godhead. [Colossians 2:9 KJV]

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Word Magick, Me-thinks, Pray-tell, Sire, “Doth the Fink Stink of Mire?” i inquire *Mr. Purificate* (sick)

In One Case King Jimmy-Stuart Translates the Same Words in the Greek as Two Different Words in the English.

In Another Case Kingly James-Charles-Stuart Translates Three Different Greek Words into the Same English Word.

Let’s just say jimmy wasn’t the best steward!

The Sire even put Elohiym’s Name in the Mire by covering it with a Title for Hire, played like a Crooked Lyre (Dan 3); Oh LORD CONFUSION הוֹיָהּ!

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Put on a Pair-O-Cleats, and Let’s Take One Last Run
Together Along the Word-Magick Trail

And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another **Comforter** (**parakletos**), that he may abide with you *forever*; John 14.16 KJV

Even the **Spirit of truth**; whom the world cannot receive, because it sees him not, neither *knows* him: **but you know him; for he dwells with you**, and shall be in you. John 14.17 KJV (disciple like living tabernacle too...think grasshopper)

I will not leave you **comfortless**: **I will come** to you. John 14.18 KJV

Judas *said to him, not Iscariot, Lord, how is it that you will manifest yourself unto us, and not unto the world?* John 14:22 KJV

Jesus answered and said unto him, **If a man love me, he will keep my words: and my Father will love him, and we will come (koinonia en hagios pneuma me thinks?)** unto him, and make our abode with him. John 14:23 KJV. Compare 2 Corinthians 13.14 with 1 John 1.3 (unity is in the Holy Spirit of the Father).

But the **Comforter (parakletos)**, which is the **Holy Ghost Spirit**, whom **the Father will send** in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you. John 14:26 KJV

But when the **Comforter (parakletos)** is come, **whom I will send** unto you from the Father, even the **Spirit of truth**, which proceeds from the Father, he shall testify of me: John 15:26 KJV

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Nevertheless, I tell you the truth; It is expedient for you that I go away: for **if I go not away, the Comforter (parakletos) will not come** unto you; but if I depart, **I will send him unto you.** John 16.7 KJV

My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not. And if any man sin, we have an **advocate Comforter (parakletos)** with the Father, **Jesus Christ the righteous**: And he is the propitiation for our sins: and not for ours only, but also for the sins of the whole world. 1 John 2:1 KJV

Wait, NOW Jesus is the (parakletos) Holy Spirit?

So Who is the Holy Spirit?

The Father is the Holy Spirit who has a Holy Spirit & Jesus Christ is also a Holy Spirit (or has the robe of the Holy Spirit) “after” His Ascension, or because of Father, who gives His Spirit to Jesus without measure (John 3.34). There is no need to add a 3rd person on these two simple accounts: 1. God is not a person because God is a Spirit

2. God the Holy Father is the Holy Spirit

Spirit upon him when he walks in the spirit (john saw it, disciples saw it)

Jesus breathed the holy spirit (after resurrection) like modeling Genesis, only here is the New Creation. Jesus is clothed in holy spirit (after ascension), liken unto Joseph’s Multi-Colored Robe in typos.

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...grieve not the **holy Spirit of God**, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption. (Ephesians 4.30) [Let the little light go on here!](#)

You will want to notice also in Ephesians 4.30 that King Jimmy Magicked things up again by capitalizing Spirit but not holy.

God the Father Puts His Spirit Upon those He Chooses

Isaiah 11.1-2, Isaiah 42.1, Isaiah 59.21, Isaiah 61.1, Numbers 11.25-26, Matthew 3.16, John 1.32-33, John 3.34, Acts 10.38

And in Jesus, the Father did so without measure John 3.34

Doesn't this Say (the Father) God is the Holy Spirit?

Wherefore I give you to understand, that no man speaking by the **Spirit of God** calls Jesus accursed: and that no man can say that Jesus is the Lord, but by the **Holy Ghost Spirit**. 1 Corinthians 12.3 HELLO

...diversities of gifts, but the same Spirit. 1 Corinthians 12.4

And wherewith when on what ~~planet~~ plane of sinful-transgression doth not the Holy God who is a Spirit possess most holy within?

Spirit of Wisdom ← please work on this Senior Scholars; frankly you aren't very good at Your Craft!
Me think you are tradition trippers that need to repent for the kingdom of god is at hand.

Deuteronomy 34.9, John 14.17, John 15.26, John 16.13, 1Corinthians 1.30, Ephesians 1.17,18, Colossians 1.8,9, Colossians 2.2-3, 2Timothy 1.7, James 3.17-18

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And Jesus said unto him, Why do you call me good? there is none good but one, that is, God. (Mark 10.18) maybe Jesus just didn't mean it

Here are my favorite Jesus Self-Titled Son of man verses !

For the Son of man is Lord → **even** ← of the sabbath day (Luke 6.5)

Is the light on yet? Ding ding uh oh!

Who do men say that I the Son of man am? (Matthew 16.13)

If you don't work hard to understand the word in Truth & Spirit, you won't be able to explain what seems a contradiction: Galatians 3.20, Ephesians 4.6, 1 Timothy 2.5; key word is between!

But to us there is but one God, the Father, of whom are all things, and we in him; and one Lord Jesus Christ, by whom are all things, and we by him. (1 Corinthians 8.6) *definitely not co-equal* [Q: Where is the Holy Spirit? A: The Father, then Jesus 2 Corinthians 3.17, then True Believers Partake "in the image" 3.18;

And when all things shall be subdued unto him, then shall the **Son also himself be subject unto him** that put all things under him, that **God** may be all in all. (1 Corinthians 15) *definitely certainly absolutely not co-equal*

Trinity = Word Magick
