

Barn Rules

1. Clean up after yourself & your horse. Sweep your mess in crossties BEFORE you get on so that grooming areas are clean for the next person. Use muck tubs to dispose of manure.
2. Put things away where they belong. Everything has a place, be sure it gets back there.
3. Throw away all trash in designated trash bins.
4. Only use lesson horse tack/equipment/brushes on lesson horses.
5. You should arrive 30 minutes BEFORE your lesson to retrieve your horse from the paddock, groom & tack. Be prepared to stay 30 minutes AFTER your lesson to cool down, groom and put away horses & tack.
6. Lesson times are not adjusted for late students. If you are late, your lesson will still end at the scheduled time.
7. Shut lights off when not in use. The last person to leave should shut off all lights & close all doors.
8. Do not use equipment or supplies that do not belong to you.
9. Lesson horse tack is not to be adjusted, switched or changed without trainer permission.
10. Free rides are for FLATTING ONLY. Jumping is only permitted during lessons & with trainer supervision.
11. Please schedule free rides during non-lesson times in winter months.
12. Supervision is required for any riders under the age of 18.
13. All riders are required to wear an ASTM certified helmet anytime when mounted.
14. Only scheduled staff is approved to feed horses hay, grain & supplements.
15. Magnawave is only to be used with permission.
16. No more than 4 horses are permitted in the indoor arena at a time.
17. All personal items & tack must be stored in a locker (boarders only), or approved bin in the storage area (See trainer about monthly storage availability). Items left out will be donated to the lesson horses.
