
LQG Block of the Month April 2025

Maple Leaf

12" finished, 12.5" unfinished

Canada Day will soon be upon us, so I thought this block would be appropriate in many ways!



## Cut from the white:

- Two squares 4.5" x 4.5"
- Two squares 4-7/8' x 4-7/8" (round up to 5" or even 5.25" like I do)

## Cut from the red:

- Three squares 4.5" x 4.5"
- Two squares 4-7/8" x4-7/8" (round up as with the white squares)
- One strip 1" x 7"

## Assembly:

For the stem block, cut one white 4.5" square in half diagonally. Fold each piece in half and finger press a crease. Do the same with the 7" red strip. Match up the crease to center each white triangle on the red strip. Sew with a *scant* ¼" seam. Press seam allowance towards the stem. Trim block to 4.5".












- For the leaf points, use the larger white and red triangles to make four HSTs. Press the seam allowances towards the red. Trim to 4.5".
- Lay out the blocks and squares, making sure the leaf points are going in the right direction.
- Sew the squares into rows, pressing in the direction shown in the second photo.
- Sew the rows together and press seam allowances towards the center.



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
