Irish Chain Variation

In Memory of Eleanor

12” finished, 12.5” unfinished



Dig through your scrap bin for this traditional palette of rich browns, medium to dark blues, and light brown tans -- not yellow beiges. (Note: my fabrics did not photograph well, the drawing on the left is better for colour) Make it as scrappy as you can, trade and share with your friends! This easy block can be arranged in many ways to create secondary patterns.

From tan scraps:

4 squares 4.5” x 4.5” and 10 squares 2.5” x 2.5”

From brown scraps:

4 squares 2.5” x 2.5”

From blue scraps:

6 squares 2.5” x 2.5”

Sew 2.5” squares into 4-patches as shown.

Arrange and sew three rows, pressing seams towards large squares.

Sew three rows together, pressing seam allowances towards center row.

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
