

Mystery Quilt Part Two

Making Pairs of the Squares cut in Part 1:

You will take squares of fabric in pair and match them with right sides together. See diagram below for making half square triangles. Each pair of squares will make 2 half square triangles.

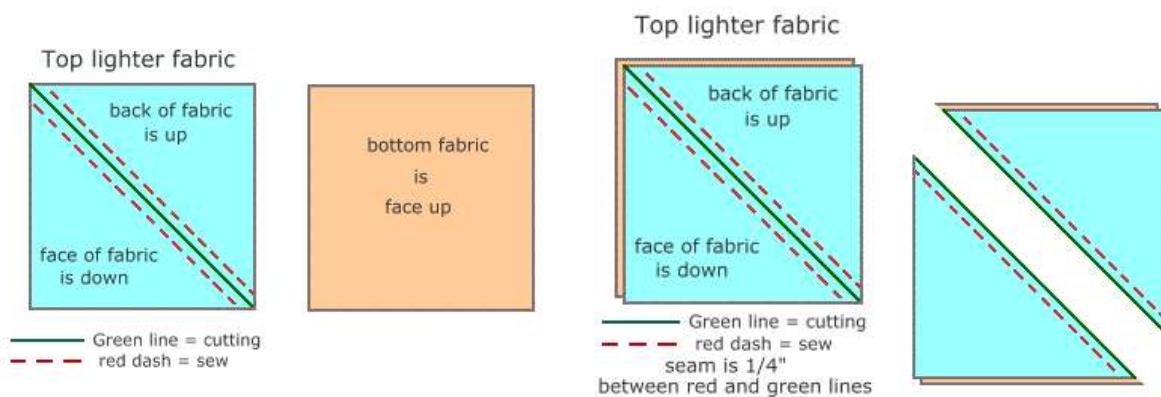
Take 14 squares of each of B Fabric and C Fabric and pair them for this step. These are your 4 ½" squares.

Take 18 squares of each of A Fabric and B Fabric and pair them. These are also the 4 ½" squares.

If you are using several different fabrics of A, B, or C – mix them when you pair them to create different half square triangles.

How to Sew & Cut Half Square Triangles:

Take 2 squares and place them right sides together. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the lighter fabric. Sew ¼" on each side of the drawn line.



Cut on the drawn line and press either open or to the dark side, whichever is your preference. Trim dog ears.
