Block of the Month October 2024

For October I've Selected another 9-patch, known to many of us as Churn Dash. Other names for it include Hole in the Barn Door, Hens and Chickens, Monkey Wrench, and Puss in the Corner. The colour placement is less traditional and gives the block a modern feel.

The colours to be used this month are black and white. Please don't use solids or tone-ontone for your white. You will need a black tone-on-tone for the outer corners, a black with very minimal white would also work. Working towards the inside of the block, select a white background with black print (about 50% black), then a black with white, then for the center a white with less black that the first one. Make a block for yourself, and one for Community Quilts.

Black tone-on-tone: 2 – 5" squares for HSTs

White with black: 1 - 2.5" x 20" strip


Black with white: 1 - 2.5" x 20" strip

White with black for center: 1 – 4.5" square

*Sew strips together along long edge and press to dark. Cut 4 sections of 4.5"

*Make four HST blocks by your favourite technique. Trim to 4.5"

*Assemble all blocks together as illustrated.
