PRODUCT DESCRIPTION: SATIN ADDITIVE

BallistiX GRENADE SATIN PACK (GR-SP) additive is a proprietary flattening agent that is designed to be used with BallistiX SINGLE COMPONENT or COUNTERATTACK wherever a satin look is desired. Coating heavily glazed or high-gloss tile surfaces with minimal available anchor pattern (surface profile) is not recommended. Do not use with Anti-Skid Additive. **GR-SP additive should only be used on matte finish substrates such as Hard Tile, Quarry Tile, Terrazzo, etc.**

GR-SP is designed to be added to BallistiX SINGLE COMPONENT or COUNTERATTACK for installations over hard surfaces when a satin finish is desired. GR-SP does not affect coating performance. GR-SP keeps satin surfaces satin.

SURFACE PREPARATION

It is of utmost importance to ensure proper surface preparation. Be sure to read any and all available pre-treatment instructions for your chosen BallistiX product and thoroughly clean the surface with BallistiX ISOPROPYL 99.

MIXING INSTRUCTIONS

BallistiX GR-SP is pre-measured for your convenience:

1 Bottle GR-SP per 1 Quart BallistiX 4 Bottles GR-SP per 1 Gallon BallistiX

- Give BallistiX SINGLE COMPONENT or COUNTERATTACK a gentle shake (see specific product instructions).
- Shake the GR-SP bottle(s) vigorously by hand for at least 30 seconds.
- Add contents of the GR-SP bottle(s) into the BallistiX quart/gallon.
- Gently shake products until completely combined.

APPLICATION

To apply, use a metal or solvent-resistant paint pan with a recommended roller, or a pump-up sprayer to apply the coating, then back-roll with recommended roller. With either method, stir or agitate the coating just before filling the paint pan or pump-up sprayer to equally distribute the matte particles in the mixture. The sprayer should be shaken every 10 minutes through the application process to keep the particles in suspension.

- Use a 9", high-quality, 3/8" microfiber roller to distribute the coating evenly across the surface of the floor. Wet out the roller prior to application.
- Always finish by lightly pulling the roller towards you in long strokes. Any excessive downward pressure on the roller or dropping it into the starting position can leave lines or roller marks in the finished product.
- For tack time, dry time and full cure time, refer to the SINGLE COMPONENT or COUNTERATTACK published Technical Data Sheets.



PRODUCT YIELD

BallistiX GR-SP additive with BallistiX products yields approximately 200+ ft² per quart or 800+ ft² per gallon, depending on application method, tile texture and grout porosity. Actual field conditions and application methods will dictate the final product yield.

POST-INSTALLATION CLEANING & MAINTENANCE

Clean with water ONLY for the first 5 days after application.

- For most general, post-installation cleaning and maintenance situations, and in order to ensure the best cleaning results without damaging the newly installed BallistiX coating, use a neutral pH cleaner (no higher than 8 on the pH scale).
- Prolonged use of the mop & bucket technique for cleaning will leave the floors dirty looking.
- Use Only Neutral pH (6-8) Cleaners and Disinfectants on BallistiX Coatings.

RECOAT INFORMATION

- If a re-coat becomes necessary, hand sand or mechanically agitate the first installed coating with a fine grit sanding screen, nylon grit brush, or abrasive pad. Wet sanding minimizes dust generation.
- Remove sanding dust before product installation. Pick up residue with rinse and vacuum extraction equipment.
- If the re-coat 'pulls away' from the first coat, stop immediately, wipe up the fresh coating with BallistiX ISO 99 and continue sanding.
