

JULY LEADERSHIP

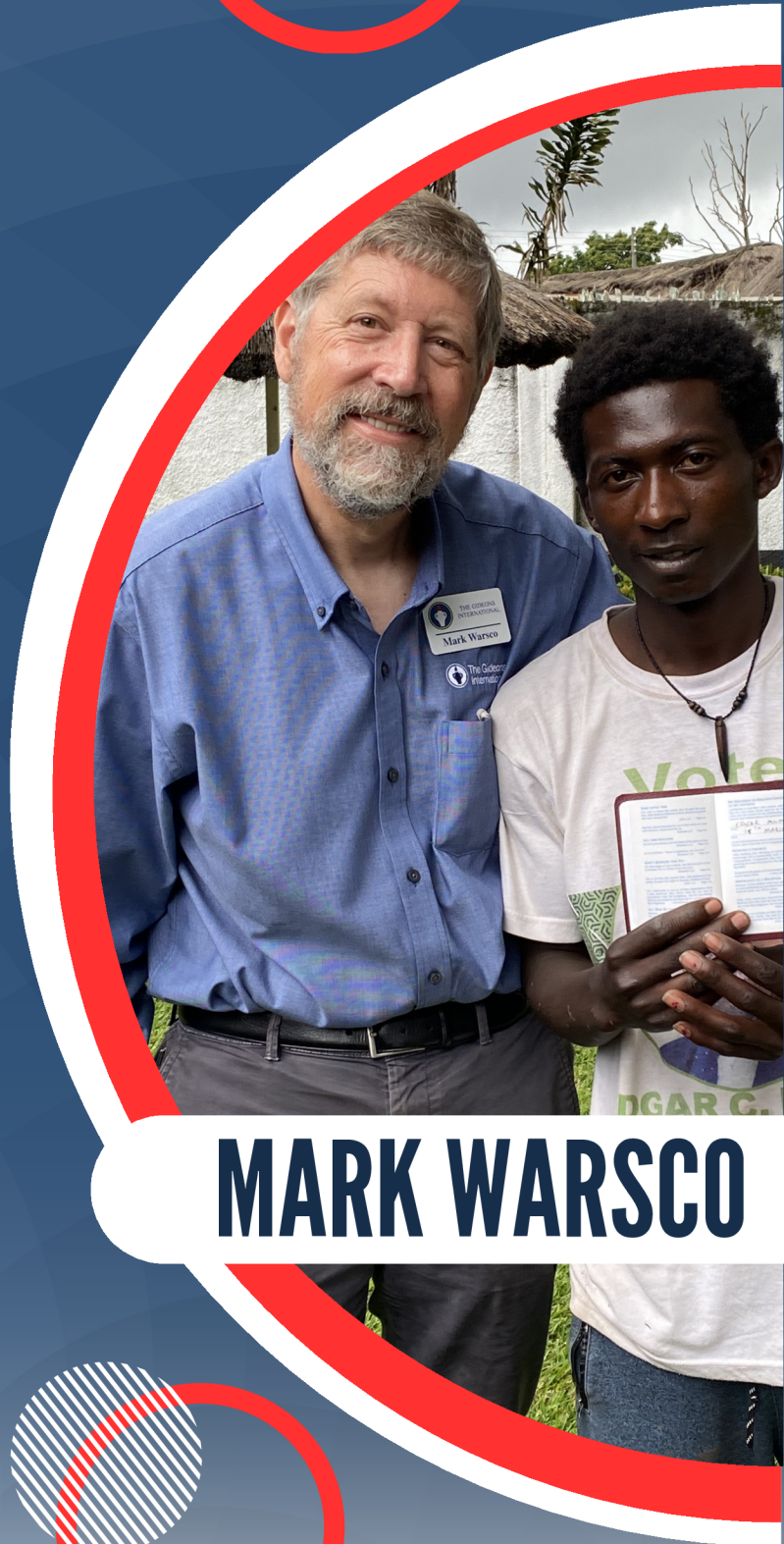
Spotlight
