- Must provide own hand tools
- Qualified candidates that do not have an Emergency Vehicle Technician (EVT) certification are given two (2) years from time of hire to obtain the certification

About the SFMD:

The Superstition Fire & Medical District (SFMD) provides all hazard response and excellent service to over 60,000 residents throughout the City of Apache Junction, as well as unincorporated areas in Gold Canyon, Goldfield Foothills, Superstition Foothills, and Entrada Del Oro. Located in the eastern most portion of the Phoenix Metropolitan area, the SFMD serves an area of approximately 62 square miles. The fire district has a distinct blend of suburban and rural residential neighborhoods, with significant seasonal fluctuation in population, intermixed with retail and commercial areas.

The SFMD operates out of five fire stations, operating 24/7/365, an administrative office, Regional Training Center, and a fleet maintenance facility. Three of our fire stations provide service within the City of Apache Junction while two fire stations serve the community of Gold Canyon, Peralta Trails, and surrounding areas. Current fire and medical services are provided by ALS Engine and Ladder companies, as well as two ALS ambulances and one part-time ALS ambulance (operating 0900-2100). Daily operational oversight is provided by a Battalion Chief and Battalion Safety Officer.
