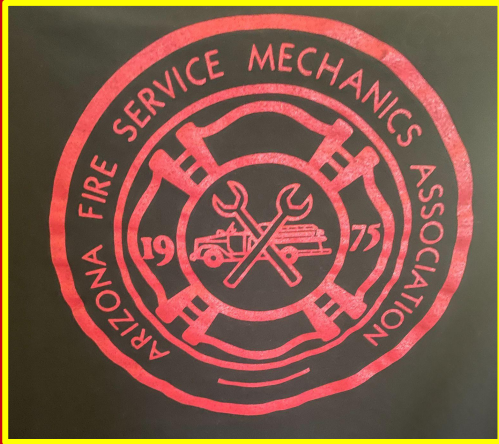


continuously regenerate the DPF without intervention by the engine controls

- **Active Regeneration**
 - Engine controls initiate regeneration, usually using a "post-injection" event
- **Manual Regeneration**
 - The technician uses a scan tool to command a regeneration cycle
