TOP-10 things to consider



1 Experience of a DJ



You don't want to hire an amateur because **"anybody could do it"**.

An expert DJ knows how to read a crowd, how to smoothly transition into toasts and first dances, etc.

Hiring a DJ with a solid track record will give you the peace of mind that they can handle all of that and more.

2 Hire a DJ in advance



Most professional DJs book their events 6-12 months in advance.

We recommend starting to look for one at the **early stage of your wedding planning**.

You don't want to leave an entertainment part with the last DJ in town.

Don't hire the cheapest DJ



Hiring a low-cost DJ service puts the **whole event at risk**.

There might be several reasons for such a low price, from cheap equipment to going out of business before your wedding. Or simply, the DJ is not experienced enough.

Ask for references



Read the **reviews and testimonials**. Is the DJ recommended in town? What do people say about him?

If there are only a few or no reviews, you might want to avoid that service.

Check the equipment



Make sure the DJ can **meet your expectations**. Also, check with the venue if they can accommodate it.

Think of any additional equipment that you need: microphone, lighting, bass, etc.

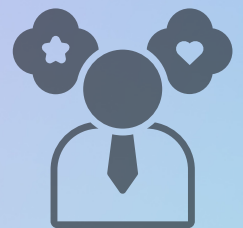
⑥ Meet with your DJ



Plan a meeting with your DJ, or at least a phone call or Zoom meeting.

You want to **get to know your DJ**, look him in the eyes and let them know you too.

⑦ Bring up Wishes & Desires



When you meet with your DJ, you should talk about your special requests, songs, and genres, MC facilitation.

If you don't **express your desires**, the DJ will simply do his own thing, and you might not like it.

⑧ Check the backup plan



We are all people, and emergencies occur. That's why we recommend hiring a DJ who can **provide a backup plan**.

The backup DJ should be equally qualified to facilitate the event.

Any Insurance



Accidents happen...and you want to minimize the risk of them.

Your DJ should have insurance with **proper liability** in order to cover any unforeseen events.

Have fun



Do not forget why you are having a wedding in the first place. Have fun!
