

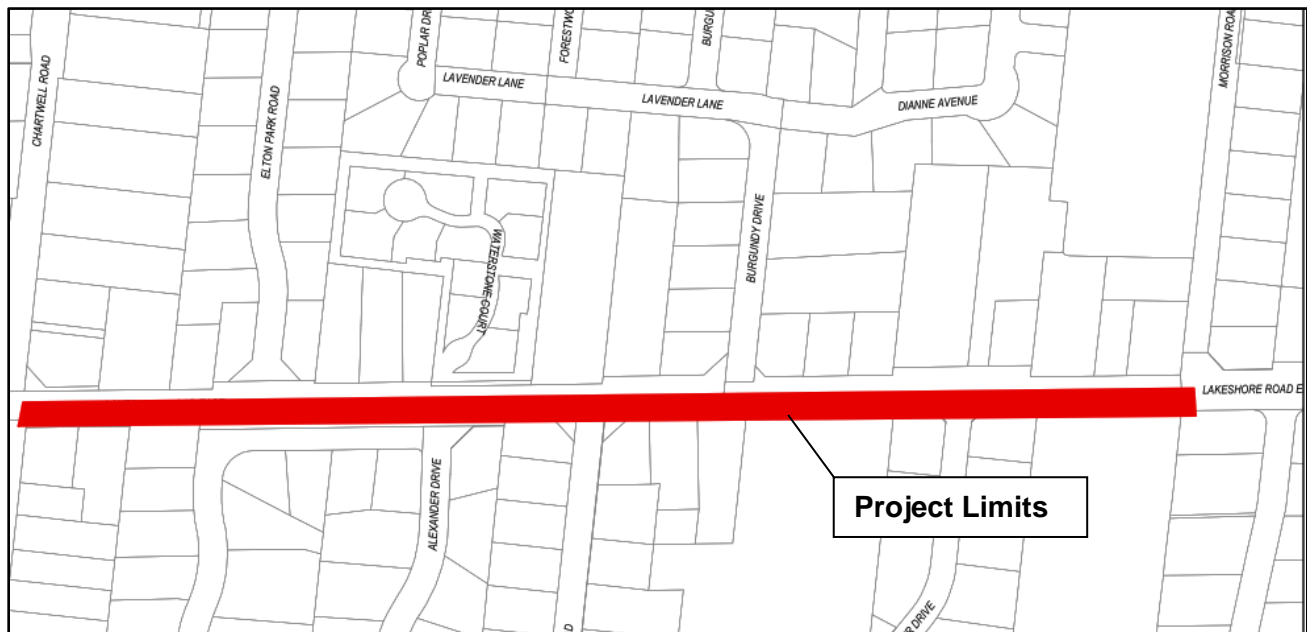

Notice of Construction: Lakeshore Road Multi-Use Trail Chartwell Road to Morrison Road

The Town of Oakville will soon be constructing a new multi-use asphalt trail on Lakeshore Road along the south boulevard between Chartwell Road and Morrison Road to promote active transportation. Improvements include:

- a new 2 to 2.4 metre wide asphalt pathway;
- upgraded pedestrian ramps; and
- boulevard grading and sod placement

The project will begin within the next few weeks and is expected to be completed in November.







What to expect during construction

The south boulevard will be closed to pedestrian access while the multi-use trail is being constructed. Pedestrian traffic will be diverted to the north sidewalk. There may be dust and noise, however the town will make every effort to reduce these impacts.

Before contractors arrive to begin the work, we ask that you please remove items located within the municipal right of way, including irrigation systems. The town will not be responsible for any damage to privately owned items on the town's property.

	Work Hours: Work will take place Monday to Friday between 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. There may be occasional work on weekends as needed.
	Sidewalk and Driveway Access: Pedestrian access within the project limits will be closed and pedestrians will be temporarily diverted to the north sidewalk during construction. If additional work is required that will temporarily restrict access to your driveway, we will notify you in advance.
	Traffic Management: Efforts will be made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users, and residents. <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Traffic will be maintained in each direction with traffic flagging as required• Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times
	Restoration: Following the construction activities, the work area will be restored with top soil, sod and/or asphalt where needed.
