COURTENEY ALEXANDRA TAYLOR (AG 29) AND HER DAUGHTER AMAYA ANAIS TAYLOR (AGE 4), BOTH OF SAN MARCOS, DIED AS A RESULT OF INJURIES SUSTAINED IN A MOTOR VEHICLE CRASH INVOLVING AN ALLEGED DUI DRIVER ON SUNDAY, APRIL 23, 2023 ON THEIR WAY HOME FROM A DAY IN THE SUN WITH THEIR FRIENDS.

COURTENEY WAS THE OLDEST/MIDDLE CHILD IN OUR FAMILY – THE RAINBOW AND THE GLUE THAT BLENDED TWO HOUSEHOLDS INTO A FAMILY. SHE WAS BORN ON NOVEMBER 23, 1993 IN MACOMB, ILLINOIS TO DAVID JR. AND BARBARA (TALLEY) TAYLOR. COURTENEY HAS TWO OLDER SISTERS, MEGAN NOEL, LAVELLA DELGADO, AND TWO YOUNGER SIBLINGS, DAVID TAYLOR III, AND KELSI TAYLOR.

COURTENEY WAS BEAUTIFUL, FUNNY, KIND, GENEROUS, PATIENT, THOUGHTFUL AND LOVING. SHE WAS A PROLIFIC READER AND HAD A DREAM OF OPENING A BOOKSTORE WITH BOOKS WRITTEN BY BLACK AUTHORS. SHE HAD A PASSION FOR HELPING OTHERS. PRIOR TO COVID SHE WAS LEARNING TO BECOME A DOULA SO SHE COULD HELP OTHER WOMEN THROUGH THEIR BIRTHING EXPERIENCE. ALTHOUGH SHE WASN'T ABLE TO GO TO HOSPITALS BECAUSE OF THE PANDEMIC, SHE WAS ABLE TO PROVIDE SUPPORT FOR SEVERAL WOMEN ONLINE AND ON THE PHONE.
