Time: Line Up at 7:00 am Parade Begins at 10:00 am

Where: See Parade Route Below

Parade Route: The Parade will start at The Richmond Hill Carver and Primary Elementary School, located at Frances Meeks Way. The parade will proceed right on Maple Street, Linwood and left on Cherry then turn left on Hwy 144, making a right on Richard R. Davis Drive and ending at J. F Gregory Park entrance on Cedar St.

Entry Cost

**ALL PAYMENTS MUST BE PAID BY CHECK; MONEY ORDER OR CERTIFIED CHECK.
NO CASH WILL BE ACCEPTED**

Entrance Fee is **\$35.00** for all participants. Each organization can have 2 units entered in the parade unless approved by parade committee.

Churches/Clubs & Alumni Groups (501c3 certified only) entrance fee will be waived. Organization must be willing to provide copy of 501c3.

Schools and Scouting organizations are free, however, An entry form must be completed in order to participate.

Deadline for all applications is January 3, 2020

All Applications must be postmark or submitted online at rhmlkparade.com by January 03, 2020. No Applications will be accepted after deadline. "No Exception"

Entrants Guidelines

1. All fees must be paid when application is turned in. Deadline Friday, January 3, 2019. Please make sure you are accurate with your vehicle descriptions, tractors pulling flatbed trailers are not cars, and if your group enters more than one vehicle into the lineup please note that on your registration. All vehicles must be marked displaying your organization's title to be entered. Example, if you are part of an auto club and you plan on participating, please state how many vehicles you will be using. All spots are based on what the registration form states, if there is only a car marked on the application, there will only be 1 spot reserved for that 1 vehicle.

2. If your organization/group will be participating, please notify all those involved with your group that there will be no cars/vehicle allowed within the parade lineup area after 9:00 a.m. unless they are an entrant in the parade. If you have children, etc, please arrange for them to meet you in J.F Gregory Park at a certain time. These persons must walk to your designated meeting location; there will be no parents, etc allowed to drive within the parameter of J.F. Gregory Park. (Road Closures – Ford Avenue & Cedar Street, as well as all side streets within this area.) Please park at the Elementary and Primary School designated parking areas located on Frances Meeks Way.

3. All parade lineup numbers will be assigned as they come in. Your assignment will be emailed to the address listed on the application – It is imperative that you print CLEARLY. If you cannot attend the mandatory meeting on Monday, January 13, 2020. You will get your line up number on Saturday morning at the Check – In at Frances Meeks Way. (Only vehicles in the parade will be allowed to check in). Once your number has been assigned, please follow the following directions given to enter the parade line up area: (please note the road closures will occur at 9:00 am sharp, and unless your vehicle is in the parade you will not be able to enter.) Please look carefully over the map enclosed in this packet.

4. If you are part of a High School Band, Marching Unit with 50+ participants, Motorcycle group, please note your line up location and remain in the designated area. You will be weaved into the parade by your corresponding numbers and on-site parade staff. All School Buses and Bands will be notified of their drop off schedule.

5. All parade entrants' line up numbers MUST always be displayed, please follow the following requirements: Cars/Trucks/etc. – display in left side of front windshield

Floats – display in left side of front windshield in vehicle pulling float.

Walking Entrants – Pin to sign or leader of the group
