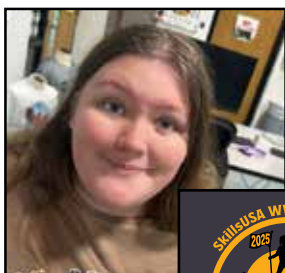

Brigadier General Murray E. "Gene" Holt, II

Brigadier General Murray E. "Gene" Holt is the Assistant Adjutant General – Army and Commander of the West Virginia Army National Guard. As the Assistant Adjutant General, he provides command and control over all Army National Guard forces assigned to the state and is the principal advisor to the Adjutant General on all matters related to the Army National Guard.

BG Holt is also serving as the Deputy Commanding General, Maneuver Support Center of Excellence (MSCoE) for the Army National Guard, assisting in the planning process and in synchronizing TRADOC efforts in training and developing maneuver support and protection capabilities for the Total Army.

BG Holt's military career spans over 39 years, beginning in 1985 as an enlisted Soldier in the West Virginia Army National Guard. BG Holt was commissioned in the US Army Corps of Engineers on 13 May 1990 through the Reserve Officer Training Corps at West Virginia State University.

BG Holt's assignments include Assistant Adjutant General Army, WVARNG; Chief of Staff, WVARNG; Commander, 111th EN BDE; Director of Operations, WVARNG; Commander, 1092nd EN BN; Executive Officer, 111th Engineer Brigade; S-3, 111th Engineer Brigade; Procurement Officer, 111th Engineer Brigade; S-4, 111th Engineer Brigade; Engineer Equipment Officer, 111th Engineer Group; Construction Management Officer, 111th Engineer Group; Environmental Trainer, WV State Area Command; Commander, 153rd Public Affairs Detachment; Platoon Leader, 3664th Maintenance Company; Press Officer, 153rd Public Affairs Detachment; Platoon Leader, A Company 1092nd Engineer Battalion; Platoon Leader (SMP), 3664th Maintenance Company.

In addition to these assignments BG Holt served as the Dual Status Commander for the 2023 National Scout Jamboree, Dual Status Commander for the 2022 Vigilant Guard Exercise, and the JTF Commander for the COVID-19 Task Force

BG Holt earned a Bachelor of Science Degree in Accounting from West Virginia State University in Institute, West Virginia and a Master of Business Administration Degree from West Virginia University in Morgantown, West Virginia. He is married to Kelly, and they have three children: 2LT Brandon Holt, a member of the WVARNG, Megan an accountant with a local firm, and a stepson CPT Paul Cooley, who is a full-time member of the West Virginia Army National Guard.

Guest Speaker

Dr. Michael “Mike” Davis

Dr. Michael “Mike” Davis began his tenure as the 27th President of Fairmont State University in July of 2023 and immediately committed himself to positioning Fairmont State as the best regional university in West Virginia.

Using the insights he gathered from listening to countless constituents ranging from students to faculty and staff, community members, business partners, international partners, and state legislators, he guided the creation of a robust Strategic Vision. This vision — for the University to become a Great Place to Learn, to Work, and to Call Home — will guide Fairmont State throughout the next decade as it seeks to educate engaged citizens in a community distinguished by opportunity, growth, and achievement, and delivers transformational impact for West Virginia and beyond.

Under President Davis’ guidance, the Fairmont State University Day of Giving set fund-raising records in each of his first two years. He created new ways for Fairmont State to engage with our local communities like the Presidential Speaker Series and community movie nights. He also changed the way the University engages with our state lawmakers. During Fairmont State’s annual Day at the Capitol, President Davis placed an emphasis on demonstrating our importance to West Virginia and ensured that Fairmont State continues to be part of vital legislative discussions concerning the state’s future. He has initiated studies to ensure equitable pay across the University and implemented further benefits to improve the lives of its employees. Finally, President Davis enhanced students’ academic and life experience at Fairmont State, and created new academic programs, new internship and externship opportunities, and a more vibrant campus experience.

Prior to assuming the leadership role at Fairmont State, Dr. Davis was Chief of Staff at James Madison University (JMU). In that role, Dr. Davis managed JMU’s presidential priorities and directed matters of policy and institutional importance, including strategic planning, institutional research, and accreditation. He was also regularly involved in external relations, crisis management and strategic communication, alumni engagement and advancement, diversity and inclusion leadership, fundraising, and fiscal management.

President Davis earned a Doctor of Philosophy in Communication Studies and a Graduate Certificate in Women’s and Gender Studies from the University of Georgia. He also holds a Master of Arts and a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Communication and Rhetorical Studies from Syracuse University. His academic research interests center on women in the Civil Rights Movement, debate pedagogy, presidential rhetoric, and argumentation and advocacy.

President Davis believes that higher education is fueled by relationships. His interactions with students, faculty, staff, alumni, parents, legislators and friends of the university foster teamwork, regularly propel innovative partnerships and position Fairmont State University as a Great Place to Learn, a to Work, and to Call Home.
