


Inspire Pinecrest Part 1 Did Not Inspire!

75% of Residents Polled REJECTED Mixed-Use Residential and Transit Oriented Development, requiring UP-ZONING.



Wed. Oct 27th, 2021, Inspire Pinecrest Conversation debuted as a VIRTUAL ONLY event led by third party moderators, consultants, market analysts and architects not by our Elected Mayor and Council.

The Virtual ONLY format created explicit limitations. We requested an IN-Person/Virtual "hybrid" combination but were refused. Recently, Pinecrest Gardens made history using COVID sniffing dogs to provide a "safe" environment for a Jazz concert in the Banyan Bowl. Critical Changes to our Community Deserve an In-Person format.

Developers often present preliminary site plans for approvals to later AMEND thus transforming communities with towering Rental Apartments festering more traffic and parking nightmares. Concerned Citizens desire to maintain our Semi-Rural Community as defined in our Charter.

- Council repeatedly assured Residents that "INSPIRE PINECREST" was a stand-alone with nothing to do with County Commissioners' RTZ proposal to force High Density creating ridership for the Bus system, yet the discussion & visuals focused on "Transit Oriented Development". These are Mixed Signals.
