Dear Southgate Parents and Families,

As we have previously shared with you, our school has been carefully monitoring the public health metrics made available by both Pima County and the Arizona Department of Health Services. Pima County has rolled out the School Vaccine Plan for K-12 Educators, by allocating specific vaccines for school personnel. We are excited as this is the beginning stages to combat the spread Coronavirus. The state allotted 29,850 doses to the County for the week beginning Feb. 1, with delivery expected by Feb. 3 at the latest.

Beginning Monday, February 8th we will return to the Hybrid Model (Options 1-4). Transportation will resume using the same routes and pick up/drop off times as it was prior to the winter break.

Southgate Academy will continue our COVID mitigation plan with face masks, social distancing, and hand washing to reduce the spread of communicable germs and viruses. Additionally, our school has purchased Protexus Electromagnetic Sprayers for each classroom to help fight the spread of infection, germs, and viruses.
