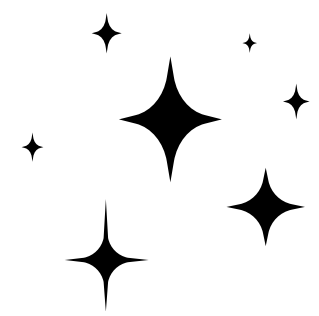


COMING SOON
